If you absolutely must come by car:

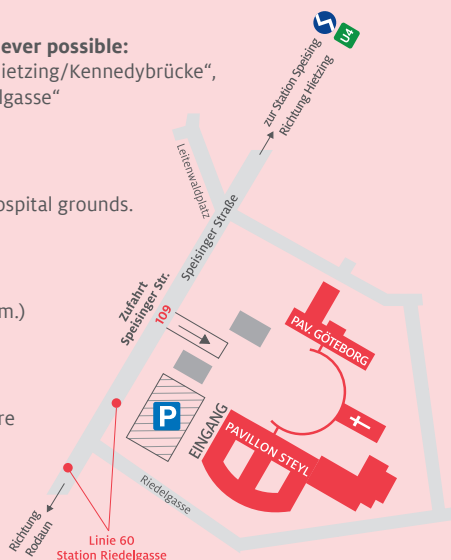
