

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter, the "Regulation"), we hereby inform you of the methods and purposes for which Nardò Technical Center s.r.l., (hereinafter "NTC" or the "Data Controller"), with registered office at Località Fattizze – 73050 S. Chiara di Nardò (LE), VAT No. and Tax ID No. 08799420016 (Certified Email: porsche-nardo@pec.it, Tel: +39 0833 877 111), as the data controller, will process your personal data collected through our video surveillance systems. **1. What personal data will you process and for what purposes?** Data regarding the date/time of entry/exit and images obtained through video surveillance systems will be processed to pursue NTC's legitimate interest in ensuring security and confidentiality within its premises and protecting company assets (Article 6(1)(f) of the Regulation). If you have consented to the retention of your data for a period longer than our standard retention periods, such processing will be carried out pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the Regulation. Please note that consent to such processing is always optional, and you may revoke it at any time by using the contact details provided in Article 8.1 bis below. **1 bis. Joint processing of personal data.** We hereby inform you that, for certain specific processing activities, NTC acts as a joint controller, pursuant to Article 26 of the Regulation, together with Porsche Engineering Group GmbH and other companies of the Porsche Group, based on a specific joint controller agreement. In particular, processing under joint controller arrangements concerns activities related to IT services and engineering services. Within the scope of these activities, the following categories of personal data may be processed, depending on the context: location data, data collected via video surveillance cameras, data from environmental sensors, and vehicle-related data, including license plate numbers. The joint controller agreement governs the respective responsibilities of the joint controllers regarding compliance with the obligations set forth in the Regulation. Pursuant to Article 26(1) of the Regulation, the designated contact point for data subjects is available at the email address: datenschutz@porsche-engineering.de. This is without prejudice to the data subject's right to exercise their rights against each joint controller, in accordance with paragraph 8 of this notice. **2. How will my data be processed, and how long will it be retained?** The processing will be carried out using automated and non-automated means, in a manner that ensures the security and confidentiality of the data. Data regarding visits to our offices will be retained for 5 days following your visit, unless you have consented to longer retention to allow for faster access to NTC locations during your next visit. In that case, your data will be retained for a maximum period of 10 years from your last visit to NTC locations. For the retention periods of images captured by video surveillance systems, please refer to paragraph 6 below. **3. Who will have access to my personal data?** The following may access your data: a) employees and staff of the Data Controller responsible for visitor reception and security; b) employees and contractors of third-party companies, including those belonging to the Porsche Group, who, on behalf of the Data Controller, perform activities related to the purposes of the processing (by way of example and without limitation: security personnel, reception staff, and those entrusted with the maintenance and development of our IT system). **4. To whom may my data be disclosed?** Your data may be disclosed to judicial authorities in the cases provided for by law, as well as to any other parties to whom disclosure is required by law. **5. Will my data be transferred?** Your data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area. The processing and storage of personal data take place on servers located in Europe. **6. Is there a video surveillance system in place?** NTC has implemented a video surveillance system, both inside and outside its facilities, to monitor access and for the safety of staff and third parties, as well as to ensure the protection of company assets. The data collected will not be disclosed (except in the event of a request by a judicial authority or law enforcement agency in cases provided for by law), nor will it be disseminated, and it is retained for the time strictly necessary to pursue the aforementioned purposes and, in any case, currently for no more than forty-eight (48) hours, and will subsequently be automatically deleted, subject to special requirements for further retention in connection with holidays or office closures, as well as in the event that a specific investigative request from the judicial authorities or law enforcement must be complied with. **7. Is providing my data mandatory or optional?** Providing your data is optional but necessary, because if you do not provide it, we will not be able to grant you access to NTC's offices. Consent to the retention of your data for a period longer than our standard retention period is optional, and you may revoke it at any time. Withdrawing your consent will not affect the processing of data that took place prior to the withdrawal. **8. What are my rights and how can I exercise them?** You have the right to request from NTC, in the cases provided for, access to your personal data, as well as the rectification or erasure of such data, the restriction of processing concerning you, or to object to the processing (Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation), and to withdraw your consent. If you believe that NTC's processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Regulation, you have the right to file a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority or the competent supervisory authority of the European Union member state in which you reside or work, or to bring the matter before the competent courts. In addition, NTC has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted regarding matters related to the processing of your data.
