You need to have your sewage treatment plant emptied and serviced regularly



A sewage treatment plant uses natural microorganisms (Biomass) to break down pollutants, many household chemicals kill these micro organisms



You can have a Smart Monitor fitted to your system to alert you to any changes

How to keep your sewage treatment plant in the best possible condition



Do's

- Service regularly in accordance with guidelines.
- Look out for bad odours. This can be a sign of overloaded biomass.
- Get the system emptied and de-sludged regularly.



Do not

- Pour neat floor cleaner, disinfectant or bleaches down sinks or outdoor gullies.
- Put food waste down the sink.
- Pour cooking oil & fat down the sink.
- Pour weed killer, insecticide & fungicide into the system
- Excess use of biological washing powder.
- Put paint thinner, white spirit, turpentine, creosote etc. into drains.
- Put nappies, wet wipes, sanitary towels & ear buds down the toilet
