Quick Guide

The Legislation

A number of Environmental Agencies across the UK and Ireland establish the proper guidelines and legal perspectives regarding pollution events arising from separators that are either poorly maintained or wrongly specified.

The legislation for each area is supported by the BS EN 858-2:2003 to help businesses act accordingly and establish correct procedures for separator installation and ongoing maintenance.

In the event of an unfortunate spillage, the environmental regulator will not only investigate instances where legislation has been incorrectly followed but will also assess whether guidance and good practices have been adopted to promote a safe and secure operation.

The Penalties

If your separator is not properly serviced and monitored, it can suffer blockages which can cause overflow or flooding, eventually polluting surrounding groundwater.

Not only will pollution from a failed separator cause significant operational downtime, but it will also have negative effects on a company's reputation and huge fines may be imposed where guidance from the EN 858-2:2003 has not been followed. Insurance coverage for a business may be jeopardized if a pollution incident occurs as a result of an incorrectly specified or inadequately maintained separator.

Quick Tips

-  Have your separator system fitted with an automatic warning device such as **SmartServ Pro II**
-  Maintain up to date and readily available cleaning and maintenance records
-  Ensure your separator is integrity tested at least once every 5 years
-  Service and maintain your separator system on a 6 monthly basis
