Share consolidation Monni (Keyware Technologies)

Brussels, Belgium – 6 May 2026 – Monni (EURONEXT Brussels: KEYW/MONNI, the Company), a leading provider of electronic payment solutions and software development, announces that its Board of Directors, authorised by the Extraordinary General Meeting of 28 April 2026, will proceed with a consolidation of all existing shares. This consolidation will be carried out at a ratio of one (1) new share for ten (10) existing shares.

The purpose of this share consolidation is to enhance the tradability and liquidity of the shares.

Details of the consolidation:

Consolidation ratio: 1 new share for 10 existing shares.

- **Number of shares subject to the consolidation:** 22,516,649 shares.
- **ISIN code of old non-consolidated shares:** BE0003880979.
- **Number of shares after the consolidation:** 2,251,664 shares.
- **ISIN code of the shares after the consolidation** BE0974503352.

All operations relating to the share consolidation will take place on Euronext Brussels.

Treatment of multiples of 10: Shareholders who hold a number of existing shares constituting a multiple of 10 do not need to take any steps or complete any formalities. Such shares will be automatically consolidated by their financial intermediary at a ratio of one (1) new share for ten (10) existing shares.

Management of fractional shares: Shareholders who do not hold a number of existing shares constituting a multiple of 10 may, until Friday 15 May 2026, buy or sell shares on the market in order to reach such a multiple.

After Friday 15 May 2026, the financial intermediaries and ABN AMRO Bank NV, in cooperation with Euroclear Belgium, will facilitate the sale of new shares, formed by the fractional shares, in order to compensate shareholders who do not hold a multiple of 10 shares.

The funds thus collected, less any brokerage costs, will be distributed pro rata by ABN AMRO Bank NV and the financial intermediaries among the shareholders on the basis of the number of existing shares they previously held, provided that the net proceeds received by a shareholder for his position with a financial intermediary amount to at least one eurocent (EUR 0.01).

Payments will only be made if the amount per shareholder is at least one eurocent (EUR 0.01). Amounts below this threshold will not be paid out.

Delisting: Non-consolidated shares at the end of the consolidation period will be delisted from the stock exchange.

Centralisation: All operations relating to the share consolidation will be carried out by ABN AMRO Bank NV in cooperation with Euroclear Belgium.

Change of company name and stock exchange ticker: In execution of the resolution of the Extraordinary General Meeting of 28 April 2026, concurrently with the listing of the new shares, the change of the company name and the adjustment of the stock exchange ticker to "MONNI" will likewise come into effect.
