Policy Summary

Your Intact Insurance Isle of Man Limited Contractors Specific Policy is a construction project insurance Policy underwritten by Intact Insurance Isle of Man Limited. Whilst titled Contractors Specific Insurance this Policy can be purchased by the Principal/Employer of the specific project.

Cover is subject to your needs and our terms and conditions.

This policy provides cover in respect of Construction Works.

You can select the cover that suits your needs from a number of optional sections within the Contractors Policy. These are:

- Public and Products Liability.
- Legal Defence Costs
- JCT Clause 6.5.1 Insurance (or equivalent).

The following covers can only be bought in addition to Contractors' "All Risks"

- Existing Buildings.
- Terrorism.

The following covers can only be bought in addition to Public and Products Liability:

- Financial Loss.
- Legionellosis.

Full details of what you have chosen will be shown in your Quotation letter and Policy Schedule.

Table 1 General Conditions and Exclusions

The following apply to the policy as a whole regardless of the specific cover you have selected. For full details of these and other exclusions and limits please read your Policy Wording/Schedule.

General Conditions and Exclusions

- If there are any changes to your business, the premises and the property therein, or any other circumstances whereby the risk is increased, you must inform us immediately. Failure to do so could invalidate the policy or result in a claim being rejected.
- You must, at your own expense, take all reasonable precautions to prevent any occurrence, or cease any activity which may give rise to liability under the policy and maintain all buildings, furnishings, works plant machinery and vehicles in reasonable condition.

Excesses and Limits

- Your policy may be subject to excesses, which are the amounts you must pay in the event of each and every claim. Certain claims limits may also apply. These will both be shown in your Policy Schedule.

Policy Exclusions (applicable to all Contractors policy wordings):

- Radioactive Contamination.
- War and Allied Risks.
- Disease (except Terrorism Insurance, Liability Insurance and JCT 6.5.1 Insurance (or equivalent)).

Important Information

Your Right to Cancel

If once you have checked your policy you decide not to proceed with our insurance you have a statutory right to cancel the policy within 14 days, starting on the date you receive your policy documentation.

You may cancel your policy by giving us notice in writing or by calling us on **01624 645900**. On receipt of your notice, we will refund any premiums already paid, except where you have already made a claim under your policy.

Making a Claim

Should you wish to make a claim under your policy please call our claims department on **01624 645900** as soon as possible. You must give us any information or help that we may reasonably ask for. You must not settle, reject, negotiate or agree to pay any claim without our written permission. Full details of how to claim are included in the policy document.

Our Complaints Procedure

We aim to give customers a high standard of service at all times. Your rights

Your rights as a customer to take legal action remain unaffected by the existence or use of any complaint procedures referred to above.

Economic, Financial or Trade Sanctions

Intact Insurance Isle of Man Limited is unable to provide insurance in circumstances where to do so would be in breach of any economic, financial or trade sanctions imposed by the United Nations or any government, governmental or judicial body or regulatory agency. Full details will be provided in your policy documentation where applicable.

Premiums and Payments

Premiums are inclusive of Insurance Premium Tax where applicable. You may pay for your policy annually or, for some policy contracts, by monthly instalments. You may be able to pay annual premiums by direct debit, credit/debit card or by cheque. Monthly instalments can only be paid by direct debit.

Renewing your policy

Shortly before each policy renewal date we will tell you the premium and terms & conditions that will apply for the following year. If you wish to change or cancel the cover you need to tell us before the renewal date.

If you pay by direct debit we will renew the policy automatically and continue collecting premiums unless you notify us that you wish to cancel the policy.

If you pay by cheque or credit / debit card, you must submit a further payment if you wish to renew the policy. You will have 14 days to cancel the policy after the renewal date and receive a refund of any premiums paid, as described in "Your right to cancel the policy" above.

Termination of the Contract

You may cancel the contract by giving us 30 days notice in writing. If you cancel the policy you may be entitled to a refund of premium provided that no claim has been made during the current period of insurance.

We may cancel this policy by giving you at least 30 days notice in writing to your last known address. This will not affect your right to make a claim for any event that happened before the cancellation date. If we cancel the policy, we will refund any premiums already paid for the remainder of the current period of insurance provided that no claim has been made since inception or renewal.

Law and language applicable to the policy

Both you and we may choose the law which applies to this contract. However, unless you and we agree otherwise, the law which applies is the law applicable in the part of the United Kingdom, Channel Islands or the Isle of Man in which you are based. Full details will be provided in your policy documentation.

The language used in this policy and any communications relating to it will be English.

Who regulates us?

Intact Insurance Isle of Man Limited is authorised and regulated by the Isle of Man Financial Services Authority. Our registration number is 007.
