Victoria's rotation story

I like getting out of my comfort zone. That's how you grow. I'm the first in my family to study abroad. I didn't know what to expect from rotation, but when I had the opportunity to move campuses, I had to take it. I started in Boston, rotated to London, and spent a summer term in Dubai.

Boston was my home campus. It's a city full of schools and everyone mixes. When I rotated to London, everyone was so welcoming. Angeel's global experience

I wanted to take on new challenges and learn from them. Rotation was my chance. I started in London. The city's energy and diversity were impossible to miss, and I learned quickly how much you gain by surrounding yourself with different perspectives. Being in a city filled with world-class universities made me raise my own standards, and building connections across industries gave me insight into just how valuable a strong professional network can be. Finally, Singapore—efficient, global, and forward-looking. Being there helped me become more structured, and visiting the Mastercard Innovation Centre during the city seminar gave me a glimpse of how fast the region is advancing. Each move left its mark. What I carry now is confidence, resilience, and the ability to thrive anywhere—skills I'll use to build a global career.







Expanding into new markets while staying true to its social mission is no small feat. In London, undergraduate students partnered with Lemonaid, a socially conscious beverage brand, designing campaigns to engage university students and co-working professionals. Acting as marketing consultants, they explored creative, purpose-driven approaches to drive both brand growth and social impact.

CHALLENGES IN ACTION

How they did it

- Market research—Explored the behaviors and preferences of university students and co-working professionals to identify engagement opportunities that stayed true to Lemonaid's social mission.
- Campaign design—Crafted impactful, targeted campaigns per segment: "Spill the Tea, Stir Up Some Good" for university students, featuring confession booths and podcast partnerships; "Catch a Break, Stir Up Some Good" for co-working spaces, with pop-up events and impact tracking to showcase measurable social outcomes.
- The proposal and outcome—Delivered fully tested strategies demonstrating practical results, social value, and commercial potential, with several ideas adopted by the client—and one participant offered a six-month internship.

If you want to intern in the US, UK, or Dubai, you can do it as part of your student visa. Our dedicated careers team will support you in finding, applying, and obtaining internships.

HULT: What inspired you to pursue this role? LEONARDO:

I've been passionate about Ferrari since I was a child. It's not just a brand, it's a symbol. When I started studying marketing at Hult, I knew I wanted to merge that passion with my professional path.

- H: How did Hult prepare you for the internship, and what kind of work did you do at Ferrari?
- Professor Mo Willan's marketing course helped me fall in love with the field, and Hult's practical approach—from business simulations to team projects—really mirrors what it's like to work inside a company. I already knew how to manage team dynamics, organize tasks, and deliver strategic presentations.

At Ferrari, I developed the model lineup (1948–2025)—documenting key specs, technical details, and visuals for internal use. I conducted market research on ultra-high-net-worth individuals, evaluated dealership performance, and delivered a 40-slide presentation with strategic growth recommendations.

- H: Did you take advantage of any career resources or networking opportunities at Hult?
- L: I worked closely with a career advisor at Hult. She helped me refine my resume to fit US standards and gave me tips on how to present myself professionally. I also attended guest speaker sessions and events at the Hult Center, where professionals from top companies shared their journeys. Listening to them gave me valuable insights and motivation.

HULT: What led you to attend Bloomberg's Insight Week, and how did you find it?

LAILA

I always wanted to work in finance, but I wasn't sure which area. During the winter break, I booked a meeting with my career advisor, Tracey Stemarthe. She walked me through my CV and LinkedIn, gave me tips, and helped me narrow my focus. Tracy encouraged me to explore opportunities posted on Handshake, where I found Bloomberg's Insight Week and applied. I booked more meetings with her before each step of the process, which really boosted my confidence.

H: How did the Hult curriculum help prepare you for the experience?

L: The timing was perfect. While attending Insight Week, I was also taking Finance B (Investment Banking & Asset Management). We managed a 1 million USD portfolio in a five-week simulation, right as major events like the Trump tariffs were unfolding. That meant when I spoke to professionals at Bloomberg, I could bring real, timely experience into our conversations. Presenting with my intern team also tested the confidence I'd built through Hult's group projects.

H: Was there a particular moment you felt proud or accomplished?

During the group presentation. I didn't expect my group to stand out, but we did, and the recruiters praised my presentation skills. It was a turning point; I realized how much my confidence had grown at Hult. Another highlight was when a fellow attendee thanked me for helping him find the confidence to speak up during the presentation. It reminded me that this experience was also about making a positive impact on others.

I worked closely with Dawn, my careers coach at Hult. We did several mock interviews, which helped me feel more confident and polished. I also got help tailoring my CV and practiced communicating why I was a strong fit. On top of that, I attended Hult's CV and LinkedIn workshops, which were practical and gave me a solid online presence.

How did your Hult experience prepare you for the workplace?

- Assessment at Hult is unique. In one project, our team meetings were recorded, and we were assessed on everything—being punctual, having agendas, taking minutes, dressing professionally. At the time, I didn't fully appreciate it, but once I got into the workplace, I saw how important those details are. Time management and presentation skills have also been key. Hult really emphasizes those, and I see now how that's set me up for success.
- What was the biggest insight you took away from the experience?
- That age doesn't define your value. I started this role at 18 and felt imposter syndrome at first. But I was treated with so much respect and given real responsibility from the start. It taught me that what really matters is what you bring to the table.

HULT: How do you help students connect with employers and gain real-world experience?

I encourage students to engage with industry professionals early and often. We bring employers to campus through panels, workshops, networking mixers, and company visits, giving students a firsthand view of the skills and mindsets companies value. They also participate in case challenges, hackathons, and projects, applying Hult skills to real-world problems rather than just listening to talks.

- What kinds of partnerships or internships do you offer through employer relations?
- One of the most rewarding parts of my job is building relationships with employers eager to hire Hult students. We work with organizations from startups to global corporations and share exclusive internships and job postings. Industry-specific events let students meet hiring managers face-to-face, and many secure internships directly through networking or company visits.
- How can students make the most of networking events and employer visits?
- Prepare, show up, and take full advantage of Hult's opportunities. The careers team provides tips, events, and resources, but students need to take the initiative and make connections themselves. Every interaction is a learning opportunity—it might not lead to a job immediately, but it can spark insights or connections that open doors. Staying curious, engaged, and consistent builds lasting professional relationships.

HULT: How do you help students discover career paths that suit their skills and interests?

I come from a recruitment background, so I know how job markets work and what employers value. In one-on-one conversations, I focus on uncovering each student's strengths, interests, and what excites them. From there, we explore how these qualities match real opportunities, helping students find a path that's both fulfilling and practical.

What support do you offer to help students get ready for internships and graduate roles?

HLN: We run interactive workshops to help students build the skills and experience they need to stand out. We help them develop their CVs, LinkedIn profiles, personal branding, portfolios, and interview skills through realistic mock sessions. One-to-one coaching builds confidence and creates tailored plans, while employer events give them direct exposure to professionals and workplace expectations.

How does your guidance help students feel confident and prepared for their careers?

HLN: I work closely with students, supporting and empowering them to trust their abilities, which gives them the clarity and confidence they often can't find alone. Having a partner helps them recognize their strengths and stay accountable. For international students, we also focus on navigating the UK job market so they can approach opportunities with confidence. Ultimately, our goal is for every student to step into their career with a clear sense of identity and excitement for what's ahead.

HULT: How do you work with the careers team?

Our visa and careers teams work hand in hand, so students don't feel like they're bouncing between two offices for answers. For example, if a student has a question about interviewing with a US employer, we can cover both the visa implications and the career strategy in one place. It's a unique model that really gives Hult graduates an advantage as they navigate the US job market.

What kind of support do you provide to students pursuing careers in the US after graduation?

We run weekly sessions on OPT and STEM OPT that you can join virtually from anywhere. When you're on campus, we encourage you to drop into office hours to ask questions in person, but once you're an alum, you still have access to our team through Zoom and email. We check our inbox daily, and if your question overlaps with career strategy, we'll immediately loop in our careers team, so you get both perspectives at the same time.

What kind of employer connections or industry exposure can Hult students expect in the US?

We keep students informed about which industries are growing and where opportunities are strongest across the US. That insight helps graduates target employers more effectively and even prepare for longer-term visa options. Just as importantly, we coach students on how to speak confidently with employers about their work authorization—shifting the focus to the value they bring to the company rather than on visa limitations. That combination of market knowledge and communication skills gives you an edge when stepping into the job market.

Post-graduation opportunities

OPT in the US

Optional Practical Training (OPT) is a type of work authorization that allows F-1 students to work in the US for 12 months after graduation to gain experience related to their field of study. Graduates of a STEM-designated degree can be eligible for up to three years of OPT.

Graduate visas in the UK

International students who complete a degree in the UK are eligible for the Graduate Immigration Route. This is an unsponsored route to work in the UK. From January 2027, Graduate visas will be granted for a period of 18 months.

Working in the UAE

International students are eligible for an employer-sponsored work visa in the UAE if they have secured a full-time role after graduation.

Growing up across South Africa, Mali, and Uganda, Marc saw both the challenges and potential of Africa. Witnessing inequality alongside the continent's rich cultures inspired him to dedicate his career to sustainable development and social entrepreneurship.

"My dream was to find the right formula to bridge business and African economic transformation. I knew business acumen would be crucial—profits can be reinvested to improve lives—but many companies weren't creating the kind of change Africa needs. Studying at Hult allowed me to explore economic development, financial markets, and entrepreneurship, and to apply these ideas in practice."

While at Hult, Marc co-founded Vertex Ecosystem to empower social entrepreneurs tackling Africa's developmental challenges. He launched Vision 2030, a social innovation venture capital fund focused on food insecurity and climate-related issues in Sub-Saharan Africa. He serves on the advisory board of several organizations addressing today's key economic, social, and ethical issues.

"Hult broke down walls between academia and the business world," he says. Building Vertex and the Vision 2030 Fund taught Marc that real change requires understanding people, political systems, and economic forces together. Hult's hands-on approach—consulting projects, international networking, and collaborative problem-solving—prepared him to turn ideas into tangible outcomes.

Today, Marc continues to scale ventures that address Africa's most pressing challenges. He combines his passion for social impact with a deep understanding of economic policy and human behavior, proving that a Hult education prepares you to transform societies.

After facing visa challenges upon graduation and working in a field she wasn't passionate about, Iva discovered event management. She started her own events company in Dubai, then pivoted to property renovation and development during the pandemic. Today, Iva runs two successful businesses in parallel.

"My priority after graduation was staying in London.

I faced visa challenges but found a job as an accountant for an SME. I learned a lot, but it wasn't right for me, so I moved to Dubai for my master's."

In Dubai, Iva secured a project manager job at Zurich International Insurance and chaired the Women's Innovation Network, where she discovered a passion for events. Following a later redundancy from another insurance company, she launched her own event management company, Iva Events.

"The pandemic heavily impacted the events industry. I'm not someone who can sit around waiting," she says. She then expanded into property renovation with a partner, founding IH Productions. The business grew rapidly, and she and her partner completed their first renovation during the pandemic, before moving into land acquisition and full-scale construction.

Meanwhile, the events business picked up, and today Iva runs two successful companies. Her time at Hult played a pivotal role in her adaptability. "The global mindset, the practical approach to solving business challenges, the teamwork and presentation skills—these are things you can, and must, apply to succeed in any career."






