What is the Hult Scholar Grant?

The Hult Scholar Grants is designed to recognize students who demonstrate outstanding personal achievement, intellectual promise, and demonstrate Hult DNA. Hult's goal is to grant full tuition support to 10% of each of its incoming undergraduate students for their chosen bachelor program and campus.



What is the Hult DNA?

Students who embody the Hult DNA are:

- **Entrepreneurial:** Students who learn by doing and put ideas into action.
- **Growth Mindset:** Students who are self-aware and adapt positively to change.
- **Leadership:** Students who speak and listen with purpose and can inspire productivity in a group while building relationships to help resolve conflict.



Personal & Academic Achievements

The ideal candidate is a proven leader both in and out of the classroom. They should demonstrate intellectual promise and curiosity which may involve the start of a social enterprise, new business or accomplishments during their time in High School. Most Hult Scholar Grant applicants achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.6 or higher in high school.



Other Requirements

Hult Scholar Grant candidates require significant financial support that will aid their education and would otherwise be unable to study at Hult. HSG applicants fill out the College Scholarship Service (CSS) profile to demonstrate financial need as part of their supplementary application materials.



Application & Deadline

Applications for the Hult Scholar Grant are completed through the following steps:

1. Submitting a standard Hult application
2. Informing your enrolment advisor that you wish to apply for the Hult Scholar Grant
3. Prepare your supplementary Hult Scholar Grant application documents
 - a. HSG Essay
 - b. HSG Letter of Recommendation
 - c. College Scholarship Service (CSS) Profile
4. Submit all HSG application materials on your Hult application by the deadline **February 3, 2027 by 11:59pm PST**
