Attendance Dues

The Attendance Dues are a Ministry of Education approved charge for all students attending Lindisfarne College – this income is used by the Proprietors to service debt and to provide major building and site works that are required for the Integrated School from time to time.

Voluntary Donations

a) Proprietors Trust Board

The Proprietors Trust Board, as a registered Charitable Trust, asks for a Voluntary Donation annually. It uses this donation to service debt obligations regarding loans for the provision of some facilities that are not part of the integrated school. These facilities are used by the students during a normal school day. A donation is also required to support the special religious character of the school. An agreed amount is also donated to the Board of Trustees annually.

Summary

a) Under Section LD 1 of the Income Tax Act 2007 these donations are tax deductible. A receipt from the Proprietors Trust Board is issued in April each year for this purpose.

b) This donation will appear on the statement as Voluntary Parental Contribution.

c) Parents will receive monthly statements from the Proprietors.

d) Donations are not subject to GST.

b) Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees receives a donation each year from the Proprietors Trust Board to maintain the smaller class sizes that have always been a unique feature of the education offered at Lindisfarne College. The Board of Trustees is not funded for the additional teachers from the Ministry of Education, for the additional consumable costs involved or the Recruitment, Retention and Responsibility allowances paid to staff to partly compensate for extracurricular activities outside the classroom.

Dayboy Lunches

As part of our Special Character all boys & staff share a communal daily meal, all dietary requirements are provided. All day boys pay this charge for the lunch provided in the school dining hall daily. This charge has been averaged over the four terms and considers seniors leaving early on exam leave.

Boarding Fees

All boarders pay this which includes all accommodation, meals etc. This charge has been averaged over the four terms and considers seniors leaving early on exam leave. This is a legally enforceable fee, and failure to pay may result in the boarder being asked to leave.

Bursary

Pupils are eligible who must live away from home to attend school, provided that certain criteria are met. Please contact the Ministry of Education for further information.

Notice of Withdrawal

1. One full term notice of withdrawal must be given in writing to the Rector.
2. The notice required must be not later than the beginning of the term at the end of which a student is to leave and if such notice is not given by the date required, then the following terms fees shall be payable.
3. Verbal notice of withdrawal will not be accepted.
4. The question of a student's withdrawal should always be a matter of consultation between the Rector and the parents/guardians.
5. Where the student is required to leave the school for a serious breach of the school rules, the full fee for the term remains payable with no refund given. "The student is subject to the rules and discipline of the school. A copy of the school rules is printed in the school handbook, and a copy is available for perusal at the school office. The school reserves the right to request the withdrawal of the student; or if necessary, to suspend or exclude the student for any serious act or omission that is in breach of the school rules."
6. Withdrawal of a student from a boarding position requires the same notice of withdrawal.

Additional charges

a) Parents' and Friends' Association

The College collects on behalf of the Parents' and Friends' Association a subscription from the parents of all students which entitles the parents to become members of the Parents' and Friends' Association. This is an annual charge and occurs during Term 2 of \$20.00 for the duration of the student's time at Lindisfarne College.

b) Lindisfarne College Old Boys' Association

The College collects, on behalf of the Old Boys' Association, a subscription of \$100.00 per year for three years at the start of Term 3, starting in the first year of the students' attendance. This entitles the student to become a life member of the Old Boys' Association once he has left the College and the full subscription has been paid.

c) Other Incidental costs

Only the take home component of curricular-based activities and any non-curricular school-based activities are charged during the term in which the student incurred the costs and are based on costs incurred by the College.

d) Sports Levy

Each month a charge of \$22.00 for years 9-13 & \$11.00 for years 7-8 will be added to each boy's account to cover sporting costs such as Affiliation Fees, Transport etc. Hockey players will be charged an additional \$20.00 per term in Terms 2 and 3 to subsidise the cost of Turf fees. Cricket players will be charged an additional \$20.00 in Terms 1 & 4 to subsidise costs.

e) Medical Fees

This charge covers minor medical requirements of students seen by the nurse or the doctor. Prescription charges and physiotherapy treatments are charged separately.

Regulations Covering Fees

1. Fees are published and shall be fixed by the Lindisfarne Proprietors Trust Board from time to time (with or without prior notice). They are payable a term in advance;
2. Fees and disbursements are payable on or before the due date for payment shown on the statement.
3. All fees and other monies not paid by the due date shall bear interest at a rate fixed from time to time by the Lindisfarne Proprietors Trust Board.
4. No fee is refundable where a student does not start or does not complete a full term;
5. Where fees remain unpaid and no arrangement has been agreed with the Bursar as to their payment, then the Lindisfarne Proprietors Trust Board will require the immediate removal of the student from the school.
