NAME LABELS

All articles of clothing must be named.

Name tapes, either woven or printed, are to have a surname and first name. Labels can be ordered at Thomson's Suits. For boarders, this includes naming mufti, towels and underwear. A minimum of 50 additional labels are to be given to the resident duty nurse.

SPORTS UNIFORM

All boys playing for a College team must be in the correct uniform if they wish to take to the field. When travelling outside the region or when representing first teams, boys will travel in their dress uniform (No.1s). At other times locally, the full College tracksuit is the only acceptable outerwear.

All students wear their playing strip for training. During winter months, when it is cold, they should wear their College sport tracksuit.

These are sold at the Uniform Shop. Specific training tops are shell jackets and can be purchased for training purposes. If you are unsure, please communicate with your coach, who will be able to detail the playing strip and training gear.

Some individual codes such as mountain biking, swimming and surfing may have specific uniform requirements outside the

approved list. In these instances, when boys arrive at the event and/or when the event finishes, they should be in the full College tracksuit.

When attending post-event functions and award ceremonies, teams will wear their dress uniform (No.1s). Undergarments such as 'skins' if worn, should not be visible.

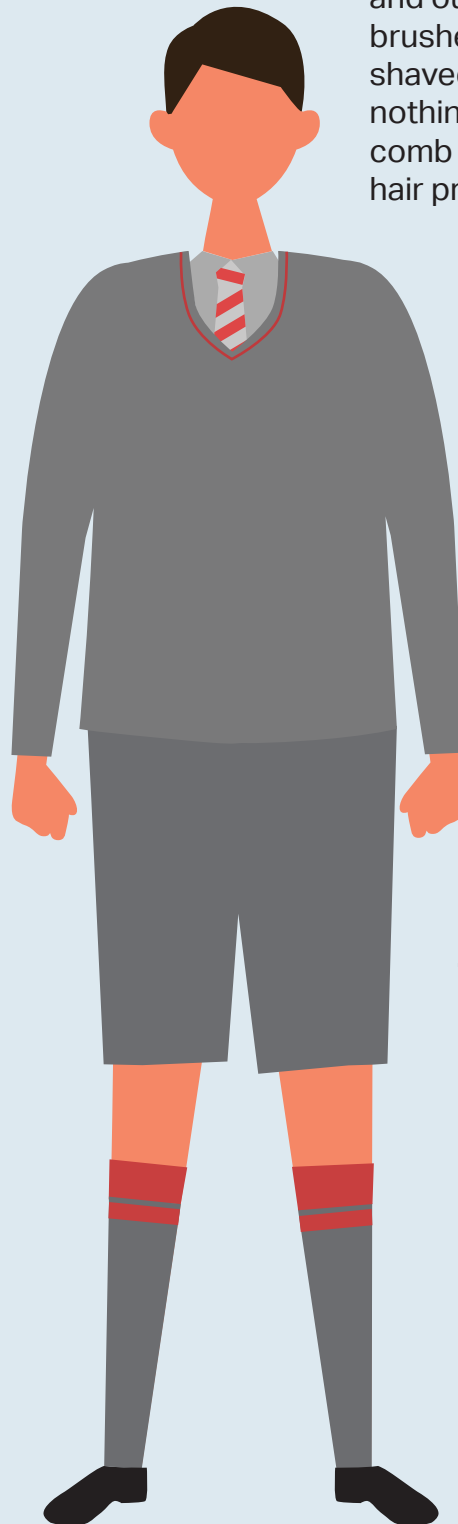
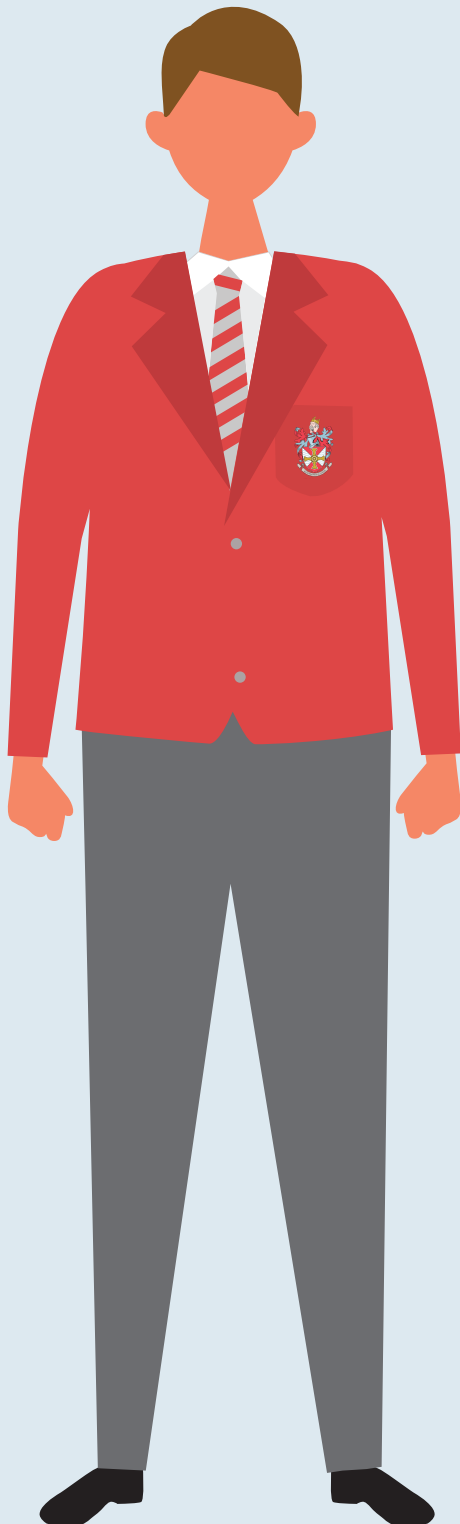

UNIFORM STANDARDS



Haircuts must be short, tidy, tapered, off the collar and ears and out of the eyes. Hair must be brushed, and natural colour. No shaved or stepped areas and nothing shorter than a number 3 comb is allowed. Gel, wax or other hair products are prohibited.

Jewellery and personal adornments are not allowed, unless approval has been given by the Rector.

The School uniform is to be worn correctly and neatly. All items must be clearly named. Uniform must be clean, pants worn on hips, ties done up. Personal **grooming** must be healthy, and hygienic. Students must be clean shaven at all times

Socks must be pulled up, **shoes** clean and polished or sandal straps secured (including back strap).

- The College launders mufti clothing for Year 7-10. Year 11-13 students have the facilities to do their own laundry. Careful consideration should be given for the ease of laundering when choosing mufti for your son to use at the College.
