

BOARDING HOUSE EXAM EXPECTATIONS

If you plan to take study leave, please review the guidelines for leave requests:

- All study leave must be requested through ORAH.
- Any changes to leave must be communicated to your Housemaster.

For those staying in boarding, please adhere to the following guidelines:

1. When attending a tutorial, wear your school uniform.
2. For exams or lunch, you must be in uniform, clean-shaven, neat, and tidy - no exceptions.
3. While studying at the hostel, note the following:
 - 3.1. Staying at the hostel is a privilege, not a right. Disregarding this may lead to consequences.
 - 3.2. Plan your study time carefully. Here's a suggested schedule:

07:15	Wake Up & Breakfast (no sleep-ins allowed, attendance at breakfast is mandatory)
08:30-10:30	First Study Session
10:30-11:00	Break
11:00-12:30	Second Study Session
13:30-15:00	Third Study Session
15:00	Break
17:30-18:15	Dinner
18:15-20:15	Fourth Study Session
20:15 onwards	Optional Study

4. Students may request to go to other gyms or town leave during the school day by emailing their Housemaster. Only once permission is given may you leave. Casual attire must be worn.

Additional Notes:

- During breaks, avoid using your computer.
- The Housemaster is not responsible for monitoring your activities.
- Keep kitchens and common areas clean and tidy; clean up after using the kitchen.
- Be considerate of others studying.
- Boarders' vehicles cannot be used during school hours unless for leave or pre-arranged with the Housemaster
- All vehicle keys must be handed in at the Medical Centre.
- No loud music is allowed during study time.
- No Takeaways/Uber Eats are permitted during the school day. All students must attend meals in the dining hall.



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
