



Boarding Enrolment Scheme

Lindisfarne is a Year 7 to 13 College for boys. It became integrated into the State System under the Integration Act 1975 on 31 January 1999. The College has a maximum roll which sets limits on dayboy and boarding places.

The order of priority for acceptance of students shall be as follows:

PREFERENTIAL STUDENTS (CRITERIA 1-5)

Students with parents or guardians who have established particular or general connection with the Special Character of the College, through an acceptance of the statement of Special Character:

CRITEREA ONE

Students who make application for enrolment prior to the date of integration on 31 January 1999.

CRITEREA TWO

Brothers of students who have attended or who currently attend the College, and the sons of Staff who are currently employed at the College.

CRITEREA THREE

Sons of former pupils of the College.

CRITEREA FOUR

Students and parents or guardians who have an established connection with the College through membership of, or affiliation with the Presbyterian Church of Aotearoa New Zealand.

CRITEREA FIVE

Applicants who are not accepted within the terms of 1 to 4 above (i.e. referred to as Merit applicants), may be offered positions on the basis of their compatibility with the special character of the school as established from information from information such as school reports and/or an interview with the Rector.

NON-PREFERENTIAL PUPILS

Up to 5% of the maximum number of pupils that the College can enrol in any year can be non-preferential pupils (which the Integration Agreement between the College and the Ministry takes as 22 boys), such pupils must be within the maximum roll.

LATE ENROLMENTS

Applications received after 18 January for the following year, will be classified as late enrolments.

For these applicants, admission to the College will depend on the above order of priority not being satisfied.

PUBLICATION

This closing date will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area serviced by the school and the Policy will be available at the School Office.
