

Great views for young and old – wintertime in the Stubai Valley

Between culinary delights, family offers and adventures on the slopes in four ski areas

In the Stubai Valley, there are countless opportunities for holidays in the snow and make a visit in the winter season particularly attractive. In October the early season opener will take place on the Stubai Glacier. From the beginning of December, the Schlick 2000 ski centre will once again offer convivial fun on the slopes. At the Elferbahnen in Neustift, the three adventurous natural toboggan runs are a special highlight. If you long for gentle slopes and idyllic winter hiking trails, you are in good hands in the area of the Serlesbahnen in Mieders. Attractive prices at ski rentals, ski schools and the free ski pass for children under the age of ten are additional arguments to visit the Stubai Valley.

Highlights in Austria's largest glacier ski area

On the Stubai Glacier, skiing is guaranteed from October to May due to the altitude. When fully operational, 65 kilometres of slopes, 36 runs and 26 cable cars and lifts are available for skiers of all skill levels. From the BIG Family Ski Camp, the Powder Department for freeriders to the Stubai Zoo Snowpark for snowboarders or freeskiers, there is something for everyone. In the Schaufelspitz restaurant, the perfect culinary finale awaits winter sports enthusiasts of all ages.

Mountain panorama and alpine cuisine in the Schlick 2000

Skiing, snowboarding, freeriding, night tobogganing, winter hiking and paragliding – the Schlick 2000 in Fulpmes is a winter sports paradise. In the modern Panorama Restaurant Kreuzjoch, connoisseurs will find their favourite place. Those who sit down on the large sun terrace can let their gaze wander from the breathtaking Kalkkögel over the Stubai Valley to the Inn Valley and are spoiled with local specialities such as Tyrolean Gröstl.

Tobogganing fun and hut magic in Neustift and Mieders

In the Elferbahnen ski area in Neustift, tobogganers are on the move in addition to alpine ski fans. Some of the longest snow-covered toboggan runs in Tyrol invite you to a winter adventure here. One of them is even open longer on selected evenings and is atmospherically illuminated. At the Serlesbahnen in Mieders you will find beginner-friendly slopes and extensive winter hiking trails. For all those who want to go downhill quickly, the toboggan run into the valley is the right choice. Face painting, cotton candy, fireworks - for children, the BIG Family Pre-New Year's Eve in Neustift End of December is the highlight at the end of the year.

One ski pass – four ski areas

With the Stubai Ski Pass, winter sports enthusiasts get access to the four ski areas of the Stubai Valley from End of November until mid of April. The pass is automatically valid in all areas for four days or more and can be purchased online at the best price. Children under the age of ten travel free of charge when accompanied by a paying parent. The ski bus between the ski areas is included.
