## Subject: Declaration of Compliance with Applicable Regulations

Dear customer,

we hereby follow up on your request to inform you that all the chemical elements contained in our products are formalized on the inspection certificates 3.1 according to EN 10204:2004, that we can supply on request, and that any other residual elements comply with the following.

### RoHS 3 – ELV – 2013/59/Euratom

Following the directives of the European Economic Community 2000/53CE (ELV), 2002/96/EC (WEEE), 2002/95CE, 2011/65/UE and 2015/863/UE (Restriction of Hazardous Substances – RoHS 3), 2013/59/Euratom e D.Lgs.241/00 (and replacing Directives 89/618/Euratom, 90/641/Euratom, 96/29/Euratom, 97/43/Euratom e 2003/122/Euratom; basic safety standards for protection against the dangers arising from exposure to ionizing radiation), 2003/11/EC and 76/769/EEC (producers of electrical and / or electronic equipments/materials are subject to compliance with its content), EU No.1272/2013 (as regards polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons),

During the processing, Sariv Srl doesn't use products that are listed in the above-mentioned directives. In addition, Sariv Srl purchases raw material and treatments from vendors that issue declarations of conformity to the directives in force.

We guarantee the conformity of our supplies in respect to what is contained therein.

### REACH

Referring to EU regulation 1907/2006, we have verified the absence on our materials of the SVCH substances present on the last update of the Candidate List available on the ECHA website (European Chemicals Agency), that have been identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). Substances on the Candidate List may subsequently become subject to Authorization by decision of the European Commission.

Based on our current knowledge, the products supplied to you do not contain any of the substances published in the most recent Candidate List above 0,1%.

Thus, we are currently not obliged to further specify the substances contained in our products according to the aforementioned articles of the REACH regulation.

### Conflict minerals RMI-EMRT

In order to comply our responsibilities, we have contacted all of our approved suppliers of raw materials, who have confirmed that the materials supplied to us do not originate from any areas of the section 1502 in agreement to the "Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act":

- Copper
- Graphite
- Nickel

We declare that our products regularly supplied to the customers do not contain the following materials defined as "Conflict minerals":

- Columbite-Tantalite (Coltan) and its derivative metal Tantalum
- Cassiterite and its derivative metal Tin
- Wolframite and its derivative Tungsten
- Gold
- Cobalt
- Mica
- Lithium

This statement is based on the declarations of the steel suppliers of Sariv Srl as well as on their own policy.
