Advancing Health in a Fragmenting World: Thank You for Accompanying us through 2025

Dear World Health Summit Community, dear all,
As 2025 comes to a close, we reflect on a year that challenged but also inspired the global health community. From the insights and impact captured in the newly released World Health Summit Report 2025 and the WHS Media Report 2025, to the many initiatives, partnerships, and discussions that shaped our shared agenda, this year has underscored the importance of collaboration, resilience, and bold action.

We have witnessed a year in which international cooperation declined, and organizations working to improve health on a global scale were faced with unprecedented cuts and challenges with respect to their mandate and scope. Reduced resources led to severe and unnecessary hardship in vulnerable and poor populations worldwide. On the other hand, many countries did start a necessary discussion on how to become more independent from external help and how to establish sustainable and equitable international cooperation for health. Countries need to strengthen their own efforts, but reliable international cooperation and partnership are indispensable. Global threats need global responses and cooperating on an international level is often the best way to serve national populations.

Looking forward, 2026 brings new opportunities to strengthen our collective efforts in that direction. We enter the new year with renewed commitment to advancing health, equity, and cooperation across borders.

I invite you to explore this month's newsletter, celebrate the achievements of 2025, and join us as we continue working together toward a healthier, more equitable world.
