The official program for the World Health Summit 2026 is now online. From October 11–13, more than 4,000 participants and 400 speakers will come together in Berlin and online for over 75 sessions under the theme **"From Crisis to Resilience: Innovating for Health."** The program brings together key global health priorities, new evidence, and perspectives from politics, science, civil society, and the private sector.
