World Health Summit 2025 Taking Responsibility for Health in a Fragmenting World

The World Health Summit (WHS) is the leading global platform for health, catalyzing solutions across sectors to improve health worldwide.

Held under the leitmotif "Taking Responsibility for Health in a Fragmenting World", the World Health Summit 2025 will take place from October 12-14 in Berlin, Germany and online. It will bring together more than 400 speakers and 4,000 participants from over 100 countries.
