 Supports regional leadership and relevance: the WHS International Presidency and host of the WHS Regional Meetings rotate annually among Academic Alliance member institutions, linking global priorities with regional perspectives

 Connects academic expertise across regions: advancing collaboration to tackle complex health challenges
