General Information

Session format of room *Forum 2*: **Workshop (WS)**

Our Workshops ensure that a broad scope of global health issues is covered. This format allows stakeholders to come together and discuss in depth the strategic actions required to achieve global health goals, shape policies, ensure intersectoral action and implement programs and initiatives at all levels of governance – global, regional, national and local.

Participant capacity on-site of room *Forum 2*: **100 PAX**

Technical Infrastructure & Equipment Information

On the **speaker area** of room *Forum 2*:

- A speaker's lectern on the right side of the speaker area with one gooseneck microphone and a digital display on the front side. The display will show the name of the current speaker at the lectern and the WHS logo.
- Two tables for up to six speakers and a gooseneck microphone for every speaker. If the panel is larger than the designated number of speaker seats, the additional speakers will have a seat reservation in the front row and they will then be able to step up to the lectern to speak.
- Handheld microphones as backup. One microphone is given to the chair at the start of the session.
- One projector screen in the middle of the speaker area and two TVs on the floor facing the speakers that will display speakers participating digitally. The projector screen will be in front of a WHS branded stage back wall.
- Additional presentation software can be added to the presentation of a speaker, but will have to be checked beforehand to see if it can be implemented. Please inform our speaker department at least two weeks prior to your session, if you plan to use additional software such as Mentimeter, Slido etc. in your presentation.

In the **audience area** of room *Forum 2*:

- Theater seating for up to 100 participants. The seats will be distributed on a first come first serve basis and reservations will not be possible. There is no guarantee of attending every session due to capacity limitations.
- The production crew will sit at the right side of the entrance. This area is not accessible for participants.
- The conference language of the World Health Summit is English. Interpretation equipment will not be provided for participants. Video messages in other languages require English subtitles.
