

## World Health Summit 2026 – Youth Group Opportunity Complimentary Tickets for Youth-led Organizations

The World Health Summit believes that young people are essential in shaping the future of health globally. To support meaningful youth participation, a number of complimentary tickets are available for youth-led organizations and groups to attend the World Health Summit 2026 in Berlin.

The World Health Summit brings together leaders from academia, politics, civil society, the private sector, and international organizations to address the most pressing health challenges of our time. Through this opportunity, youth organizations can contribute their perspectives, experiences, and ideas to global discussions while connecting with stakeholders from around the world.

This initiative is part of the World Health Summit's commitment to fostering diversity, inclusivity, and intergenerational dialogue in global health.

### What Is Included

Selected applicants will receive complimentary access to the World Health Summit 2026, including:

- Full access to all three conference days
- Participation in keynote sessions, panel discussions, and networking opportunities
- Access to coffee breaks, lunches, and social evening events
- Opportunities to engage with global health leaders, experts, and fellow youth advocates
- A platform to bring youth perspectives into international health discussions

### Who Can Apply

Youth-led organizations, networks, and groups working in health, youth empowerment, education, advocacy, social impact, or related fields are eligible to apply.

- Organizations must primarily represent young people and demonstrate active engagement within their communities
- Participants nominated for complimentary tickets must be **28 years of age or younger** at the time of WHS
- Applications from individuals will not be considered
- A maximum of **15 complimentary tickets** and a **minimum of 3 tickets** may be requested per organization

Applications from diverse groups and organizations are particularly welcome, including those representing underrepresented regions, marginalized populations, and a broad range of social, cultural, and professional backgrounds. Diversity considerations will be taken into account during the selection process.

Interested organizations must submit their application through the online application form.

- Your organization's focus and field of work
- Your motivation for participating in the World Health Summit 2026
- An example of your work and its impact
- The topics you would like to engage with and how you will share your experience
