Proper care for long-lasting windows



Environmental and weather influences

Dust, soot as well as exhaust fumes leave marks on your windows. Discoloration can occur, especially in combination with sunlight. To prevent that from happening, regular cleaning is key. that.



Holistic care

Not only the glass, but also the window frames, sashes and window rebates require regular attention. Thorough cleaning of all components ensures a permanently appealing appearance and functionality.



Gentle cleaning

Use a soft cloth and neutral soap to protect the materials and prevent damage. Aggressive cleaning agents or scouring pads should be avoided.

Congratulations on your Salamander window! Here you can find out why it's important to look after it.

The first steps to properly care for your window's immediately installation:

1. The protective film must be removed immediately after installation to prevent it from sticking.
2. First basic cleaning after installation: Removes dust from the former construction site and installation residues.
3. Check fittings and seals for cleanliness and function: Remove any coarse soiling.
4. Clean the drainage openings: Important for a functioning water drainage (see p. 9).

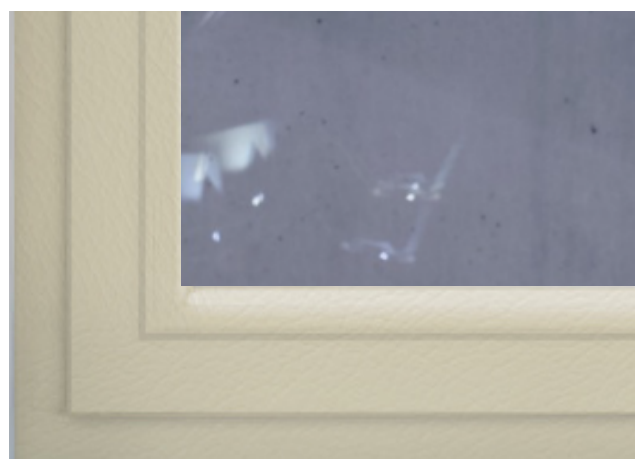

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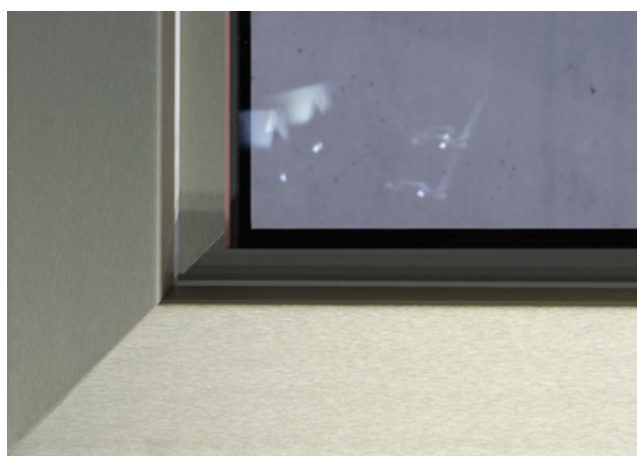

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Let your facade shine

Care down to the last crevice

Regular care protects your windows from dirt and discoloration. With just a few simple steps, you can ensure that your windows and seals remain beautiful and functional in the long term.

Cleaning frames

- A soft cloth with clear, lukewarm water is usually sufficient.
- For heavier soiling: pH-neutral soap or a cleaner specially tested for plastic windows.

Important

- No abrasive sponges, brushes or solvents.
- Do not use a steam cleaner! The hot steam can damage the plastic.
- Remove sunscreen residues immediately to avoid visual changes.

Cleaning of seals

- Wipe the seals with a mild cleaning agent and a soft cloth.
- Then rinse with water to remove any residue.

Important

- Check seals once a year for cracks or deformation.
- Only use approved care products to maintain the elasticity of seals.
- Check sealing joints between frame & masonry annually.



Shine that lasts, care that protects

Care, even superficial

With just a few simple steps, you can ensure that your window surfaces and drainage openings shine and remain functional in the long term.

Cleaning surfaces

- Plastic surfaces: With lukewarm water and mild detergent.
- Aluminum surfaces: Regular care with a neutral cleaner and soft sponge.

Important

- Do not use aggressive cleaning agents such as alcohol or ammonia.
- Soft cloths and sponges to avoid scratches.
- Always rinse thoroughly with clean water after cleaning.



Cleaning of drainage openings

- Check openings once a year for blockages and clean.
- If necessary, clean with cotton bud or small brush to remove any deposits.

Important

- Do not use sharp objects or chemicals.
- Regular cleaning prevents the drainage openings from becoming blocked.
- If water has leaked in, it must be able to drain away.



No-gos for your window

These cleaners damage surfaces

Not every cleaner is for your windows. Certain ingredients the surface, make it brittle or lead to unsightly discoloration. To preserve the longevity and flawless look of your windows, you should definitely avoid using the following cleaning agents.



No-go cleaning agents

- **Dissolving agents** e.g. nail polish remover, alcohol or ammonia
- **Cleaning agent** with orange, lemon or peppermint flavoring
- **Agents containing sulphur** e.g. tile cleaner
- **Abrasive agents**, steel and scouring sponges, microfiber cloths

If you use the wrong cleaning agents, this may lead to unpleasant results: The surface can turn yellow, becomes dull or will even be damaged. Harsh chemicals and abrasive materials attack the material and shorten the life of your windows. It's better to use suitable cleaners - this will keep your windows beautiful and intact in the long run.
