For whom is this role?

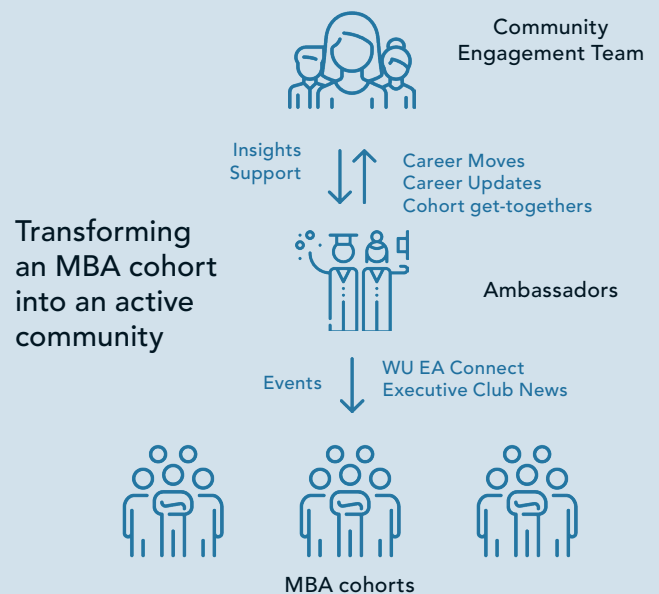
The role of an Alumni Ambassador is designed for motivated and committed alumni/alumnae (e.g. former Class Representatives).

Responsibilities and Requirements

- › Organizing Alumni get-together
- › Promoting events within their class community
- › Engaging with participants at events
- › Regularly using WU EA Connect
- › Sharing Club news & updates in their class
- › Encouraging WU EA Connect data updates
