

Day 1 - Arrival

Arrive and settle in.


6:30pm: Meet in hotel lounge for a welcome introduction before dinner.



9:30am: After breakfast meet in Hotel Garden Room (which will be the base meeting point for the group). Walk through Herm Harbour Village past The Herm Shop and Mermaid Tavern along the path bordering Fisherman's Bay with views of Guernsey, Hermetier and Herm's oyster beds. Continue to Herm Common and onwards to Oyster Point and the Pierre Aux Rats obelisk for sketching and painting.

12:30pm: Packed lunch delivered. 3pm: Return to hotel for free time.

From 7pm: Dinner served with optional post-dinner sunset painting.




Day 3 - Puffin Bay Cliffs

9:30am: Meet and climb Rosaire steps, tracing the cliff path above Puffin Bay with sweeping views towards Jethou, Sark, Brecqhou, Jersey and the French coast. May brings opportunities to see the southernmost puffin colony in Europe nesting here.

12:30pm: Packed lunch delivered. 3pm: Return to hotel for free time.

From 7pm: Dinner served (optional post-dinner sunset painting).









Day 4 - Harbour Hill, St Tugual's & Shell Beach

9:30am: Meet and walk up Harbour Hill, passing the Zen Garden in Valley Panto, created during Herm's covid lockdown to provide a tranquil, quiet space. Carry on to the viewing platform with views across to Guernsey or continue to the beautiful 11th Century St Tugual's Chapel and Manor Village. You can choose to paint anywhere in this area or opt to continue to Shell Beach down the Spine Road. Shell Beach sand is made up of millions of tiny shell fragments, which are washed in by the Gulf Stream.

12:30pm: Packed lunch delivered. 3pm: Return to hotel for free time. From 7pm: Dinner served.

Day 5 - Belvoir Bay

9:30am: Meet and walk up Harbour Hill, via St Tugual's Chapel and down through a wooded valley towards Belvoir Bay. Paint from the viewpoint or beach, with vistas towards Sark, Brecqhou and, on clear days, the French coast.

12:30pm: Packed lunch delivered.

Return around 3pm.

Dinner at 7pm with a final opportunity for sunset studies.

Day 6 - Departure

Farewells and departure from Herm.









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
