

## 5.7 Junior Membership

### Definition

Junior membership of Boundless by CSMA is defined in the Articles of Association paragraphs B19 – B21.

### Purpose

The reason for Junior Membership of Boundless by CSMA was outlined in a meeting of the Board of Directors on 3rd September 2010 and the following statement was included in the minutes of that meeting.

“Under Motorsports UK regulations junior members under age 18 can compete in autotests, rallies, karting, marshalling and associated activities if they are a registered, card holding member of an affiliated motor club”

### Process

In order to join Boundless by CSMA applications for Junior Members follow a similar process as Adult Members: Junior Members will be introduced by a current Boundless by CSMA Voting Member who is a close relation. This can be done either by telephone to the Membership Services Department or by completing an application form. It should be stated clearly at the start of the call or on the application form that it is a Junior Member Application.

A brief outline of Junior Membership is as follows

- Junior Membership is only available for children between the ages of 10 – 17 (evidence of date of birth should be requested)
- They are required to be a close relation of a full voting member
- They will not be able to vote at, or receive notification of, general meetings (i.e. AGM)
- They will not receive a magazine, nor should they be included in any Marketing communications
- Their membership will cease automatically when they reach 18
- Junior memberships will be directly attached to a full voting membership. Should that full member ceases their membership, the junior membership will also cease (unless they are transferred/attached to a different full member which must be confirmed with Member Services)
- Junior membership is able to run with different renewal dates to the full membership to whom they are attached
- Junior Members will receive an appropriate Membership Card to enable them to be eligible to compete in Motorsports UK regulated motoring events under the auspices of Boundless by CSMA

- Previous Junior members are eligible and will be encouraged to apply to be full voting members, when they reach age 18
- Junior Membership will be free (as of Sept 2019)

### Associated Documents

Boundless by CSMA has guidance relating to Child Protection Issues which is contained in this handbook in Section 5.2i. This guidance states:

*Junior Membership of Boundless by CSMA is provided for Close Relations of Voting Members, primarily for competition in junior classes at Motorsport events organised by Motor Clubs throughout the country.*

*Boundless by CSMA only promotes Motorsport events that include Junior Classes where the Junior must be accompanied.*
