Grass Autotests We still don't have a venue yet, but we are invited to all the Blackbird AC ones, which are held at a field at Towcester. The entry fee for these events is £30 and entries are limited to 25, as only one test is run at a time, but there are usually six different tests run. They are running an event each month between May and September, so why not join John Clavey and myself.

Londinium Pedito This is a treasure hunt on foot. This event leads entrants on a historical and educational tour (combined with a "quiz") of some of the less known, yet interesting, areas of the City. It may be participated in as a social event or one with a competitive nature – for many it is a mixture of both. The event takes place on a Sunday afternoon. The overall route is circular, comprising six sections. For each, a competing team is allowed thirty minutes. Also, each section will have a different style of route (perhaps a map, descriptive, or photographic) to present the competitor with some navigational challenge. Over the course of each section they will be expected to answer a dozen questions - these are all to be answered from permanent features within the City, e.g. inscriptions on monuments, Blue Plaques, Architect stones, etc. By starting competitors at two minute intervals from each of the six starts, we are able to avoid any grouping around the route. Typically the first competitors will start at 1:00 pm and the last at 1:28 pm, thereby the last scheduled finisher will be at 4:28 (although some lateness may occur). A communal finish is optionally attended where provisional results are announced. Teams comprise one or two persons, although there is a "mini" event which runs concurrently and is aimed at older persons or those with young children (e.g. in push chairs). The total number of teams is normally about 120 (to achieve this a few teams start at minute intervals). The event takes place entirely on the streets (footpaths) and public spaces of the City of London. Entries cost £20 per team and entries close on Monday 7th September.

12 Car Insurance The new insurance process for our 12 Car rallies, now sees the MSUK taking on the role of Broker and clubs will now pay the MSUK any insurance payments as part of the permit process. The one major change is that organisers must take a photo of the insurance signing-on sheet and email it to the MSUK before the event starts. This does allow a bit more leeway to organisers, as you don't need to decide to take out insurance cover, you just have to pay for those that want it. This means if someone turns up at the start and wants to change cars to one that needs the cover, then this can be catered for, even if no one else required it. Also, the levi for arranging the insurance has also gone, which means less cost to the event, if someone needs the cover. From a competitor point of view, there will not be any change to what they do to enter or take the cover. With this new process, it sees the amount competitors have to pay to use it, has reduced down to £35 per event.
