A floor that connects spaces

**A home in Ticino features the artistic diversity of Swiss manufacturer Bauwerk Parkett's Formpark parquet collection for creative, stylish flooring.**



*The private residence of a family in Ticino was enhanced in terms of functionality and adapted to contemporary living needs. A consistent material concept defines the building and brings light, space, and movement into harmonious balance. Carefully composed, high-quality wooden floors from Bauwerk Parkett create a warm, inviting atmosphere and enhance the character of the interior spaces.*

With the addition of a bedroom and a bathroom, the home gained new spatial qualities. The CC Consulenze e Costruzioni SA architecture firm from Vezia, Switzerland, carefully planned the conversion, improving the existing structure. "Our intention was to open up the architecture and at the same time, create a calm, warm atmosphere," said Christian Carroccio, the owner of the architecture firm. "The floor plays a starring role: it connects all the spaces."

## **Nordic style and artistic depth**

The spatial concept was based on a Nordic-style modern design, characterised by abundant daylight and generously proportioned passages. Wide doors and an open layout create flowing views, which are further highlighted by the wood surfaces. The goal

was to achieve a uniform floor appearance – from the living spaces to the private rooms – that unites the different zones despite their functional differences.

They chose modern, 2-layer Formpark parquet from Bauwerk Parkett. “Formpark impressed us with its clarity and playfulness,” explained Carroccio. “The system is simple – which is why it is extremely versatile.” Two formats are sufficient to achieve very different effects depending on how the floor is laid and the incident light: quiet or vibrant, classic or contemporary. Seamless transitions from one pattern to another are also possible. The floor is not just a surface; it becomes part of the architectural concept.

Formpark Mini was used on the upper floor. Its smaller size allows for high creative density within a limited space. “Formpark Mini is ideal for showing character in smaller spaces,” said Carroccio. “The format permits creative patterns without overloading the room – it adds texture while avoiding friction.”

On the ground floor, the specialist partner Piazza Pavimenti installed Formpark, and Formpark Mini was placed on the upper floor – both formats in natural oiled oak. The wood originates from responsible European forestry, and the natural oiled surfaces help promote a healthy indoor climate.

### **Custom details crafted with Swiss precision**

The details received particular attention: for instance, the parquet was installed around the fireplace with an accuracy of one-tenth of a millimetre. At the company headquarters in St. Margrethen, Bauwerk Parkett's in-house production department was also able to craft customised oak ventilation grilles and nosing for the interior staircases. To create the nosing, the wood is bent almost seamlessly around the edges to fully encircle the stair structure with wood cladding. “This precision was the deciding factor for us,” stated Carroccio. “You feel that Bauwerk Parkett embraces Swiss quality down to the smallest details.”

### **Ambience and usage**

Today, the house is seen as warm, bright, and full of positive energy. The parquet floor has proven to withstand daily use in a household with children and a dog. “The floor is robust, easy to care for, and very tactile at the same time,” said the architect. “This is exactly the combination we aimed for.” The range from design to practical use shows that a carefully chosen floor not only serves a purpose but also creates a welcoming atmosphere – supporting the architecture in the best way.






