



Bankrupt debtor: Northvolt AB, 559015-8894

The bankruptcy administrator has assessed that a distribution may be appropriate in the bankruptcy. The court has therefore decided to implement a monitoring procedure.

You may need to register your claim for monitoring.

- You must register your claim for monitoring if you want it to be considered for a possible distribution in the bankruptcy. Please note that this applies even if you have already registered your claim with the bankruptcy administrator.
- If you have received payment in advance, you are obliged to register your claim for monitoring.
- If you have received payment through the wage guarantee, you do not need to register your claim.

Notification for monitoring must be made in writing to the district court **no later than 21 August 2026**.

Please send the documents by email in PDF format (all documents in a single PDF file) to stockholms.tingsratt.konkurs@dom.se or digitally, preferably in PDF format. In that case, they do not need to be submitted in any other way. Information on how to submit documents digitally is available at www.domstol.se/skickadigitalt.

For information about the content of the notification, see below.

What should a report contain?

- Information on the size of the claim on the date on which the debtor was declared bankrupt (with the amount specified for each individual claim)
- For claims with preferential rights: information that there are preferential rights and the basis for these
- Invoices or other documents supporting each claim
- Information about the total amount you are monitoring in the bankruptcy
- Payment information (bank transfer or, for international payments, IBAN and SWIFT/BIC)
- Contact details for the creditor/agent monitoring the claim

Objection to monitored claim

If anyone wishes to object to a claim that is being monitored, they may file an objection. The objection must be in writing and submitted to the district court **no later than 30 October 2026**.

Notifications received are available at the district court. After the last day for notification and up to the last day for objection, they are also available for inspection at the administrator's office:

If anyone has made a complaint, a conciliation meeting will be held at the district court on 23 November 2026 at 9.00 a.m.

Bankruptcy administrator's fee

When the administrator requests remuneration, certain creditors will be summoned to a hearing or given the opportunity to express their views. This applies to every known creditor with special preferential rights to property for which there is reason to determine special remuneration. Other creditors will be summoned or given the opportunity to express their views only if they so request.
