First time setting or resetting a password:

Go to <https://aka.ms/sspr>, enter your UPN (this looks like mailaddress), which is first name firstinitial@tilburguniversity.edu or studentnumber@campus.uvt.nl (for example u123456@campus.uvt.nl), complete the captcha, and click "Next."
(you will receive your UPN from your program manager before the start of the program)

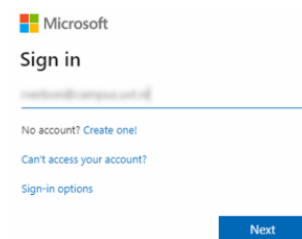
In order to protect your account, we need you to enter your complete mobile phone number (*14) below. You will then receive a text message with a verification code which can be used to reset your password.

Set up Microsoft Authenticator

The first time you log in with your account, follow the steps to link the Microsoft Authenticator. The setup page is automatically shown when logging into Canvas or on the page where you request a password reset. Below are the steps for setting it up

1. Enter your UPN (firstinitial.lastname@tilburguniversity.edu or studentnumber@campus.uvt.nl) and choose Next

3. Download the Microsoft Authenticator app or open it on your phone and choose Next



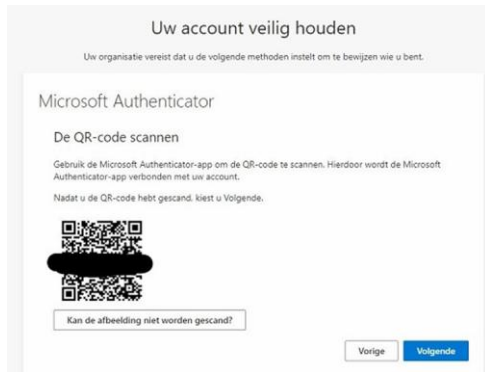

4. Open the Microsoft Authenticator app, allow notifications if prompted. Choose the option to add an account and select "Work or school." Tap Next on the page

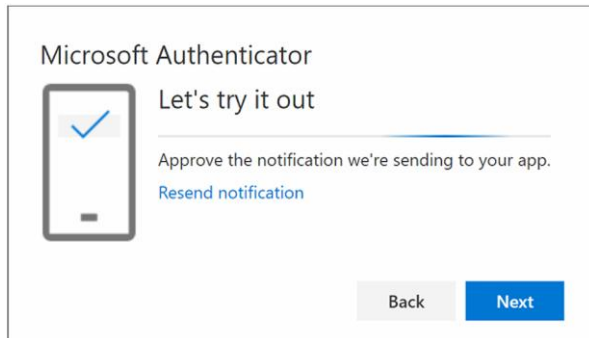

5. Choose the option to scan the QR code in the Microsoft Authenticator app and scan the code on the screen. Once that's done, choose "Next" on the page



6. Approve the test notification in the authenticator app



Once you have completed the steps, the Microsoft Authenticator will be linked to your phone.

Canvas:

Canvas login: For all TIAS Canvas users, logging in via MFA applies (see [MFA manual](#)). To do this, you need your UPN (User Principal Name).

Haven't set a password yet, forgotten your password, or need your username? Set or reset your password via the [Tilburg University's password reset page](#).

Log in with your UPN, which is firstinitial.lastname@tilburguniversity.edu or studentnumber@campus.uvt.nl (for example U123456@campus.uvt.nl). After logging in, an authenticator request will appear on your phone. If you haven't set up the authenticator yet, follow the steps for that. If the authenticator doesn't show up on your phone, contact IT Support at Tilburg University by phone at: 013-4662222.

A common problem is that a work or personal Microsoft account tries to log in automatically. If that happens, visit <https://www.tias.edu/en/login> in an InPrivate window of your web browser. You can open an InPrivate window by clicking the top right in your browser or using the keyboard shortcut "Ctrl Shift N" (or "Command Shift N" for Apple/MacBook).

Eduframe (Student Information System):

Go to <https://www.tias.edu/en/login> and select Student Information System and log in with your UPN, which is `firstname.lastname@tilburguniversity.edu` or `studentnumber@campus.uvt.nl` (for example `U123456@campus.uvt.nl`).

Logging in to the wifi (Eduroam):

How to connect to a wireless network: eduroam This can be done in 3 simple steps:

- Connect to the eduroam wifi network
- Enter your username and password. The username is: `studentnumber@uvt.nl` (for example `U12345@uvt.nl`) and your password
- If prompted, accept the suggested security certificate

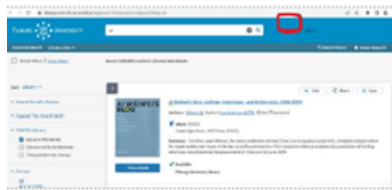
For Android phones that don't automatically detect the settings, it's recommended to connect via the GetEduroam app:

<https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=app.eduroam.geteduroam&pli=1>. Search for Tilburg University in the app, choose "Connect", log in with your `student number@uvt.nl` and your password. If logging into the Wi-Fi doesn't work, you can also get a guest login by scanning the QR code on the screen at the entrance. The guest login is valid for 24 hours.
