MODERN SLAVERY ACT TRANSPARENCY STATEMENT

This statement has been published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015. It sets out the steps taken by The Ashridge (Bonar Law Memorial) Trust as at the year ending 31st December 2024 to prevent modern slavery and human trafficking in its business and supply chains.

Introduction

Ashridge is a charitable trust enacted by statute that undertakes teaching and research relevant to all business sectors which is widely disseminated through publications, online content and programs delivered to individuals and apprentices, and to clients and their employees based internationally.

Commitment

We recognise that modern slavery is a significant global human rights issue and includes human trafficking (for domestic or sex work and other forms of labour), forced and bonded labour, some forms of child labour, and domestic servitude. Our commitment focuses on the offered teaching and research on the subject matter whilst recognising that we have an overall responsibility to act ethically and with integrity in all our relationships and take reasonable action to prevent and prohibit slavery in all its forms.

Risks in our supply chains

Ashridge acknowledges that whilst the risk of modern slavery is low; there are risks linked to global supply chains and services that we procure. Ashridge contracts its facilities and associated services from EF Corporate Education Ltd – an organisation that sets documented standards of all their suppliers and contractors in relation to labour conditions, business integrity, heath, safety, and social performance and assures strict adherence with those standards.

Statement

Ashridge is satisfied with the effectiveness of the measures it has taken in the last financial year to combat slavery and human trafficking. Ashridge will continue to develop more effective strategies and tools to reduce, and preferably eliminate, the potential for any contravention of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

This Modern Slavery Act Transparency Statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes the human trafficking statement as at the financial year ending 31st December 2024 for The Ashridge (Bonar Law Memorial) Trust.
