



Clinical Nurse Specialist – Dementia

Applications are invited for the above 3 Year Specific Purpose Position.

The Organisation:

Stewarts is a voluntary organisation providing comprehensive community based services to people with an intellectual disability. We support people with a wide range of support needs across residential settings, day services, supported independent living, job advocacy and vocational training.

The Role:

The primary function of this role is to provide direct specialist care to individuals with Intellectual Disability and dementia in partnership with the Multi-Disciplinary Team, families and key workers. To enhance the person's development (physically, emotionally, cognitively, socially and spiritually), promote health and an optimum quality of life. To collaborate with the Multi-Disciplinary health care team both interdisciplinary at service level and in the wider service including generic services.

Candidates must meet the following criteria relevant to the role:

- Be a registered RNID or RGN and registered in a Division of the register of Nurses and Midwives in which the application is being made or in exceptional circumstances, which will be assessed on a case by case basis be registered in another Division of the register of Nurses and Midwives.
- A minimum of five years post registration (of which two must be in the specialised area).
- Have undertaken formal recognised post registration education in the specialist area of Dementia, Gerontology or a related area at Higher Diploma level or equivalent (level 8) on the NQAI framework.
- Demonstrate evidence of continuing professional development.

Salary and qualifications are in accordance with Department of Health & Children Regulations and HSE consolidated pay scales: Clinical Nurse Manager 2 Salary Scale: €50,912 to €60,190 per annum.
