The Organisation:

Stewarts Care is a long established voluntary organisation providing comprehensive community based services to people with an intellectual disability in the West Dublin area. Stewarts is the lead agency for the above newly established interdisciplinary CDNT teams, CDNT5 and 6, in line with Progressing Children's Disability Services. These teams will be based in Stewarts Care Palmerstown and Rossecourt, Lucan.

Purpose of the Post:

To provide a quality, evidence based and family centered physiotherapy service to children and young people (0 – 18 years) with complex needs within an interdisciplinary framework.

The service provides assessment and implementation of physiotherapy intervention and provision of essential equipment, postural management and orthotics as part of community disability network services within a family centered model of care.

This is an exciting opportunity to work as part of a new and dynamic team.

To be considered for this post applicants must demonstrate the following:

- BSc or equivalent recognized professional qualification in Physiotherapy approved by CORU
- Physiotherapist must maintain annual registration on the Physiotherapy Register maintained by the Physiotherapy Registration Board at CORU.
- Relevant ICT skills.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal and team work skills
- Planning and organisational skills and effective time management skills
- Evidence of participation in continued professional development in paediatrics e.g. Bobath, Bayleys training is desirable
- Experience working in in the area of Intellectual Disabilities and or Disability Services would be an advantage
- Experience in postural management and orthotics is desirable
- Experience in paediatrics in acute and or community services is desirable
- Knowledge of Community Healthcare Organisation Governance of Children's Disability Network Service would be an advantage
- Have a full clean driving license and access to a car is desirable
