Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Paris today.

Day 2: Arrival in Paris

Included meals: welcome dinner
Welcome to France! Meet your Tour Director
and fellow Group Coordinators at tonight's
welcome dinner, served with beer or wine.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Paris & Seine dinner cruise

Included meals: breakfast, dinner
Today, get to know the architecture, scenery,
and history of The City of Light's 20
neighborhoods—or arrondissements—during a
guided tour.

- Drive down the sycamore-lined Champs-Élysées to view the Arc de Triomphe, which was commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 in honor of his victory at the Battle of Austerlitz. Completed after his death in 1836, this iconic French symbol houses the country's Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and several famous sculptures depicting the French Revolution.
- Pass the oldest bridge that crosses the Seine River—Pont Neuf, or "new bridge"—and the legendary Notre-Dame Cathedral, located on an island in the river.
- See the Eiffel Tower, the ornate Palais Garnier opera house, and Place de la Concorde—the city's largest public square, flanked by two columned buildings and eight statues representing the provincial capitals.
- Marvel at the iconic architecture of the Louvre, home to some of the most seminal artwork from across the ages, and Hôtel des Invalides, the final resting place of Napoleon himself.

Take in the nighttime allure of the City of Light during an evening cruise on the Seine River. Coast under Paris' bridges and behold the illuminated monuments of the city glittering alongside the riverbanks—all while indulging in an included dinner, served with your choice of beer or wine.

Day 4: Convention Tour meeting & New Year's Eve celebration

Join your group for a Convention Tour meeting,
a series of presentations and discussions
designed with Group Coordinators' questions,
experiences, and interests in mind.

- Begin with a keynote address by senior members of Go Ahead Tours staff, followed by an insider's view of the company and tours

Day 5: The Palace of Versailles, gardens & afternoon tea

Travel outside of Paris to the iconic Palace of
Versailles, the most magnificent château in all of
France.

- Learn how this once-small hunting lodge was expanded into such grandeur that it is still the envy of royalty worldwide.
- See the palace in all its glory as you tour the State Apartments and the glittering Hall of Mirrors. Lined with 357 French-made mirrors, it saw the signing of the Treaty of Versailles in 1919, which ended World War I.
- Stroll through the lavish gardens to admire their fine statues, splendid fountains, and colorful flowerbeds.
- Sit down for afternoon tea, during which you'll be treated to fine specialties Marie-Antoinette would have enjoyed: Vienna-style brioche rolls, blinis, sandwiches, and delectable pastries.

Day 6: Parisian baking class & signature

farewell dinner

Included meals: breakfast, tasting, farewell dinner

Head to a nearby culinary school this morning, where you'll join an experienced local chef for a Parisian baking class.

- Learn the elegant art of crafting French pâtisseries during an interactive and educational baking demonstration.
- Sample a seasonal, iconic French confection and learn all of the tips and tricks behind how it's made.

Next, travel to Le Ciel de Paris restaurant, which is situated 650 feet above Paris inside Montparnasse Tower.

- Enjoy panoramic views of the city skyline and the Eiffel Tower's evening light show.
- Sit down to celebrate your trip during a three-course farewell dinner, served with beer or wine, while taking in sweeping views of the city.
