Alaska Convention

Anchorage, Alaska → 1 night

Day 1: Arrival in Anchorage

Included meals: light dinner
Welcome to Alaska! Settle in to your hotel this evening.

Denali, Alaska → 2 nights

Day 2: Convention Tour meeting & transfer to Denali

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner
Join your group for a Convention Tour meeting,
a series of presentations and discussions
designed with Group Coordinators' questions,
experiences, and interests in mind.

- Begin with a keynote address by a senior members of Go Ahead Tours' staff, followed by an insider's view of the company and its tours
- Discuss tour-planning and recruiting best practices with Go Ahead Tours staff and your fellow Group Coordinators
- Get an overview of the many benefits available to you as a Go Ahead Tours Group Coordinator and learn about new program updates
- Enjoy a break with coffee, tea, and biscuits After an included lunch, make your way north across the Last Frontier to Denali.

Day 3: Sightseeing tour of Denali National Park

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner
A full day of sightseeing with your guide
immerses you in the scenery, flora, and fauna of
Denali National Park.

- Grab your boxed lunch and head out to look for wildlife, such as grizzly bears, moose, wolves, caribou, and eagles, on one of the park buses
- See Denali, North America's tallest mountain (weather-dependent)
- Enter the Murie Science and Learning Center for a ranger-led talk about the park's ecosystem and ongoing conservation efforts

Enjoy an included dinner with your group this evening.

Talkeetna → 1 night

Day 4: Morning Denali wilderness walk & train ride to Talkeetna

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
Enjoy an opportunity to relax at the hotel this
morning, or return to Denali National Park for an
in-depth walking tour focused on the park's flora
and fauna.

- Join a naturalist guide, who will point out various landmarks and talk about Alaska's geology and glacial history
- Walk through boreal forests and discover how plants and animals have adapted to the extreme, sub-arctic climate
- Gain a new perspective on this region's natural beauty as you explore the landscapes and spot the animals who call it home

This afternoon, travel as a group to the historic village of Talkeetna via the Alaska Railroad.

- Pass over Hurricane Gulch Bridge, the longest and tallest bridge on the Alaska Railroad
- Enjoy views of the Alaskan wilderness as the conductor makes sighting announcements
- Savor an included lunch in the train's fullservice dining room

Seward, Alaska → 2 nights

Day 5: Transfer to Seward

Included meals: breakfast, dinner

Make your way to the Kenai Peninsula today,
stopping to visit the Alaska Wildlife Conservation
Center to learn about the organization's animal
rescue work.

Then, continue on through the Kenai Mountain Range to Seward, where you'll sit down for an included dinner.

Day 6: Kenai Fjords National Park cruise

Included meals: breakfast, lunch, farewell dinner Embark on a private cruise through the waterways of Kenai Fjords National Park to experience the panoramic glacial views the area is known for.

- Float along the pristine waters on the Kenai Peninsula
- Try to spot wildlife, such as birds and whales

• Enjoy an included boxed lunch Return to the Seward Marina and celebrate your trip with your fellow travelers at tonight's farewell dinner.

Overnight Flight → 1 night

Day 7: Anchorage via Portage & departure

Included meals: breakfast, lunch
Spend a free morning in Seward before heading back to Anchorage, paying a visit to Portage along the way.

- Stop at Portage Lake to enter the Begich Boggs Visitor Center
- Soak in spectacular views of Explorer Glacier, which sits at an elevation of about 2,200 feet

Continue on to Anchorage and sit down for an included lunch. Then, transfer to the airport for your overnight flight home.
