

# Programming Options

## In-person Options:

*A two-hour interactive program covering at least 8 areas of disability, accommodating approximately 80 participants, held at the Tolleson Family Activity Center (once re-opened and safe for all).*

- **For Students**

*Field trip! Students meet, connect with, and ask questions of people living with disabilities in a safe environment.*

- **Teacher Training**

*Teachers gain a better understanding and are equipped with ideas to accommodate and include students who have various differences.*

- **Community Groups**

*Families/groups experience the program together, sparking meaningful connections and conversations.*

## Virtual Options:

- **Classroom Cohort Program: Teacher-facilitated**

*Teachers complete online lessons on their own schedule. These classrooms will also have the opportunity to virtually interact with at least eight of our Leaders.*

- **Online To Be Like Me Class: TBLM Staff-directed**

*Eight 45-minute classes led by To Be Like Me staff. Participants learn about at least eight different areas of disability and virtually interact with at least eight of our Leaders.*

- **Online Zoom Speakers**

*Sign up to virtually interact with our Leaders (typically 30-45 minutes).*
