

The first floor dining space, bar and deck continues the design language, music and dining experience from Future Future opened in August 2018.

The interior dining space can accommodate up to 30 guests for seated events and 40 guests for standing events.

The outdoor deck can accommodate up to 25 guests seated and 35 standing*

* the outdoor deck is weather dependent and no contingency is allowed for in the event of inclement weather.

JANUARY TO OCTOBER

booking confirmation

Tentative bookings will be held for a maximum duration of 7 days. During this period a deposit of \$500 must be paid in full to secure the space. If a deposit is not received within 7 days Future Future reserves the right to accept other enquiry for this date.

Bookings will only be confirmed upon receipt of a signed copy of the terms and conditions form and payment of the deposit. The deposit amount will be deducted from the total bill at the end of the event. The deposit is fully refundable up to 14 days prior to the event.

Cancellations with less than 14 days notice will forfeit the deposit. Cancellations with less than 72 hours notice will be charged the remaining 75% of the minimum spend specified for their event. Payment must be finalised by cash or credit card on the day, at the conclusion of the event or prior to the event taking place. Any payment made by bank cheque or EFT must be approved and settled prior to event date.

Minimum spend requirements

Monday to Thursday \$1,500.

Friday, Saturday \$2,000.

An additional hire fee will apply for exclusive use of the outdoor deck space during opening hours.

All events must conclude at their scheduled time and in accordance with the venues liquor license restrictions. The maximum duration for events is 4 hours unless an extension is agreed upon prior to the event taking place. All events with a commencement time of 8pm are subject to a maximum 3 hour duration in order to comply with liquor licensing restrictions.

A service charge will apply for events scheduled on a Sunday or Public Holiday. Sunday events will incur at 10% service charge and increasing to 15% on public holidays 15%.

menu selection

All guests attending your event must be catered for. Menu and beverage selections are required one week prior to your event. Should selections not be advised by this point Future Future will select a menu on your behalf. Future Future reserves the right to substitute menu items of a similar quality, due to supplier shortages and seasonal change. The event organiser will be informed in advance of any changes. Special dietary requirements must be communicated to us one week prior to your event, and confirmation of final numbers must be advised 3 business days ahead of your reservation.

external suppliers

Future Future does not allow any external food products to be brought into the venue with the exception of a birthday cake. This must be pre-organised as part of the event booking and brought in the day of the event between the hours 11am - 12am or 2.30pm - 4.30pm. There will be a cakeage fee of \$3pp.

If you are wanting to use decorations such as flowers or audio visual screens, you must consult with the events manager prior to making any bookings. Decorations that are deemed inappropriate by Future Future will be refused. All external companies will be approved at the discretion of the events manager. Should external suppliers be approved, it is the responsibility of the client to ensure that all external property is removed at the end of the event. Storage of items overnight is not permitted.

restaurant rights

Future Future will not be held responsible for the loss of or damage to property left on premise prior to, during, or after an event. Organisers will be financially responsible for any damage to the building, furniture or property during and immediately following the event, including any costs for repair or replacement at current market price. The organisers of the event are responsible for damage caused by their guests, outside contractors or agents prior to, during and after the event. The client is required to inform all relevant persons involved in the organisation of the event, including colleagues or contractors of Congress' Terms and Conditions outlined herein.

All staff at Future Future are trained in the Liquor Licencing Accredited Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) and by the way of law may refuse to serve alcohol to any person who they believe to be intoxicated. Any intoxicated person will be removed from the premises. In accordance with liquor licensing laws of Victoria, minors are only permitted on the premises in the direct company of their parent or legal guardian and may be asked to leave the venue at the discretion of management. At no time is a minor permitted to consume alcohol on the premises. Drinks may be served up until 11pm, and guests are required to vacate the premises by 11:30pm due to licensing restrictions.

NOVEMBER TO DECEMBER

booking confirmation
