

MYSTERIOUS MUMMIES



What you'll need:

- Wood scraps
- Sandpaper
- Mitre saw
- Black and white paint
- Drill
- Paintbrush
- Hole saw
- White bandages

1

Cut two wooden boards to size: 20 x 30 cm and 25 x 35 cm.

2

Cut two square base pieces large enough to hold the upright planks.

3

Attach the rectangular planks onto the bases.

4

Use the hole saw to cut out four circles. Paint them to look like eyes.

5

Sand all the edges smooth.

6

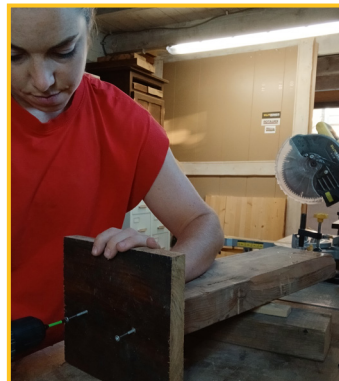
Wrap the boards with white bandages.

Tip!

Rub some coffee grounds or sand over the bandages to give your "mummies" an aged look.

7

Attach the painted circles onto the wrapped boards. They'll be the mummies' eyes.



Your mummies are ready to give the neighbours a fright!

FREAKY FRANKENSTEIN

What you'll need:

- Wood scraps
- Mitre saw
- Drill
- Sandpaper
- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Four sturdy bolts
- Staples, nails, screws...



1

Cut two wooden boards to size: 25 x 25 cm and 25 x 30 cm.

2

Sand the edges smooth.

3

Paint the boards green.

4

Get creative and paint the faces of the monster and his bride.

5

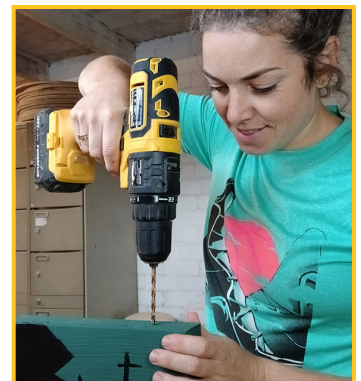
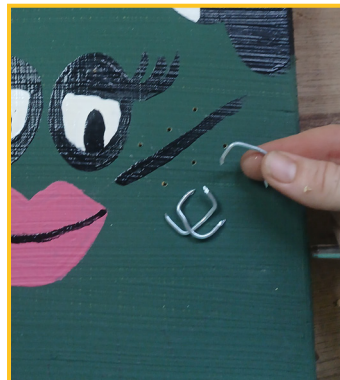
Use staples, screws, or other metal parts to mimic scars on the head.

6

Drill holes at the bottom (what will be the "neck") of the heads for the bolts.

7

Screw the bolts into the predrilled holes.
