

### List of Core Subjects for grades 10-11

<b>English Credit</b>	American Literature; British Literature; English (III, IV)
<b>History Credit</b>	History; World History; American History; U.S. History and Geography; Government; British History; Current Issues; American Studies; World Studies; Economics
<b>Math Credit</b>	Mathematics; Arithmetic; Algebra; Geometry; Elementary Functions; Calculus; Math. Analysis; Trigonometry; Computer Mathematics; Analysis
<b>Science Credit</b>	Life Science; Astronomy; Oceanography; Natural Resources; Botanic; Marine Science; Geology; Meteorology; Biology; Lab. Biology Anatomy; Physiology; Molecular Biology; Ecobiology; Ecology Lab. Science; Genetics; Geology; Lab. Geology; Earth Science; Zoology

Students to convalidate grades 10 and 11 will have to take at least 4 subjects from the list above. It's recommended that 2 of them are English and History, but this is not mandatory.

The student will have to choose the subjects of the grade that he/she wants to convalidate. As an exception, the grades could be from a grade above, including a letter from the school principal explaining that it isn't offered on the grade of the student.
