



Protected Disclosures Annual Report 2025

The Chief Executive Officer of SOLAS is the person prescribed by the Minister of Public Expenditure and Reform to receive disclosures on all matters relating to the regulation, registration, employment and education of apprentices as provided for by the Industrial Training Act 1G67 (No. 5 of 1G67) and the funding of further education and training as provided for by the Further Education and Training Act 2013 (No. 25 of 2013).

This report sets out the number of protected disclosures received by SOLAS in 2025 and has been prepared in accordance with Section 22(5) of the Protected Disclosures Act 2014 (“the Act”).

SOLAS has established internal and external reporting channels and procedures in accordance with the Act.

In 2025, SOLAS received one report of alleged relevant wrongdoing through its external reporting channels. Follow-up was conducted and the report was closed by SOLAS, since follow up was being conducted by another body.

SOLAS completed follow up action on two reports that remained open at the end of 2024. Both reports were closed in 2025. One had been referred to another body in 2024; the other was closed with no wrongdoing found.

In 2025, SOLAS received no reports of alleged relevant wrongdoing through its internal reporting channel.
