Marshalling of Aircraft onto Stand

It has been identified through safety monitoring that Aircraft have been seen to be marshalled past their nosewheel markings (where applicable).

This is a reminder to all marshallers that where an aircraft nosewheel marking is designated this must be adhered to when marshalling aircraft. There is currently a live exception detailed in OAN 17/21 for East Apron stands 70-73 all aircraft types and stand 78 for b767-200 only.

All marshalling licence holders, please familiarise yourself with the stands markings you are marshalling onto prior to controlling the aircraft.
