1.0. SUMMARY

This information notice is to remind all airside vehicle operators that vehicles with expired vehicle permits are not permitted to remain airside.


2.0. PROCEDURE

During COVID-19 Manchester Airport took a risk-based decision in collaboration with vehicle operators that allowed 'mothballed' equipment to remain airside. At the Airfield Safety and Strategy group meeting held on the 22nd July 2021 it was determined that this process would be revoked from the 9th August 2021.

Therefore, any vehicles that remain airside without an appropriate AVP will be subject to an Airfield Occurrence Report and Infringement. Manchester Airport also reserves the right to recover vehicles at the cost of the vehicle operator.
