
FUEL VEHICLE ACCESS AND EGRESS

It was raised at the Airside Safety Committee that vehicles and equipment are being left in positions blocking the access and egress routes for Fuel Vehicles.

<u>Access</u>: When positioning equipment to service an aircraft, please ensure a clear route is available for the fuel vehicles to also service the aircraft.

<u>Egress:</u> For your safety and the safety of others, all operators are reminded that fuel vehicles must have a clear exit route away from any aircraft. Vehicles and equipment must not be parked or stopped in an area that could impede fuel vehicle egress.

Please work with the Fuelling Operators to ensure situations like the below are avoided.
