

ROADWORKS A453 NOVEMBER 2021

Leicester County Council and National Highways will be carrying out essential highway maintenance night-time works in November on the A453 Ashby Road carriageway. The works will take place in two phases commencing on 1st November 2021 through to 18th November 2021.

Phase 1 - 1st November to 11th November 2021

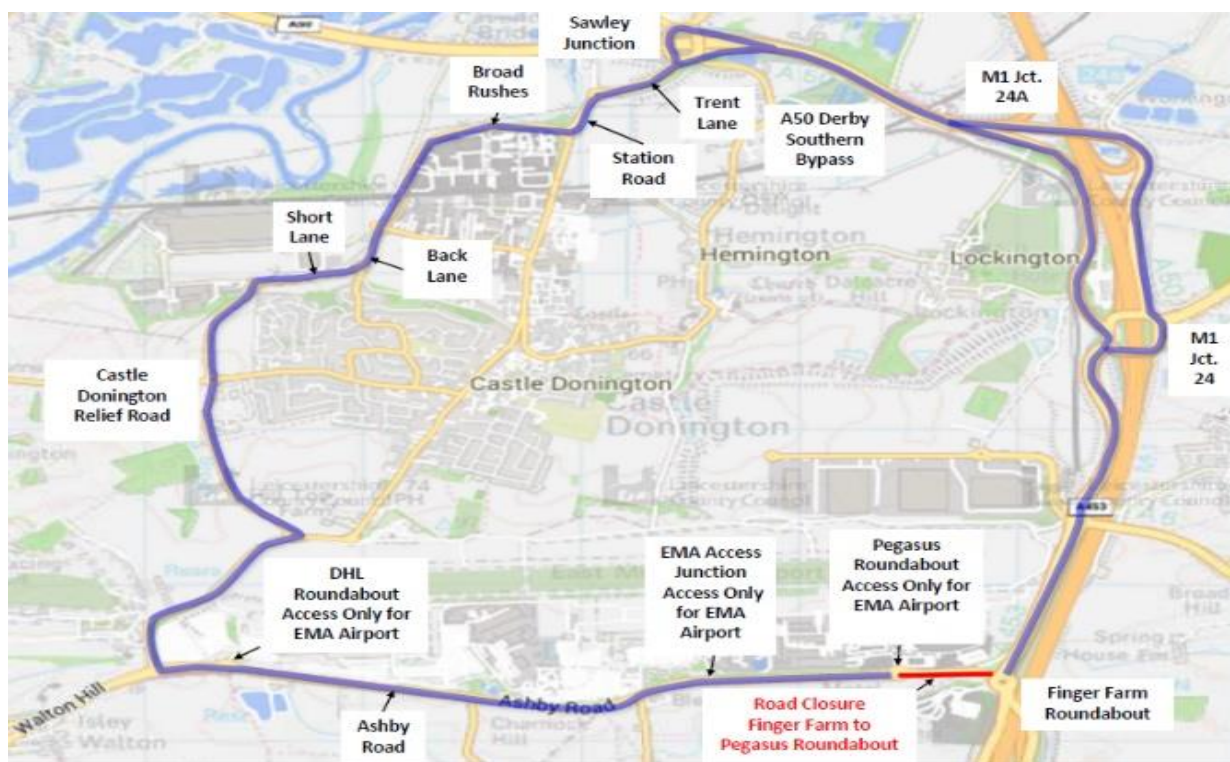
Work will commence on the A453 Ashby Road between the Pegasus roundabout and MOTO Services roundabout, in the direction of travel towards East Midlands Airport/Pegasus Business Park.

The road will be fully closed at night-time only at this point between 20:00-06:00 Monday to Friday, a diversion route will be in place – details attached.

Access to the Airport campus will be maintained from the West via the JetParks / DHL roundabout or via the Main Entrance, accessed from the north or west only.

Access to Pegasus Business Park will be maintained throughout from the West JetParks / DHL roundabout or via the Main Entrance, accessed from the north or west only.

*NOTE. There will be no access to the airport from the south / east approach (M1J23A/A453 Finger Farm Roundabout). Road users will be required to follow diversion signs in place.



Phase 2 - 12th November to 18th November 2021

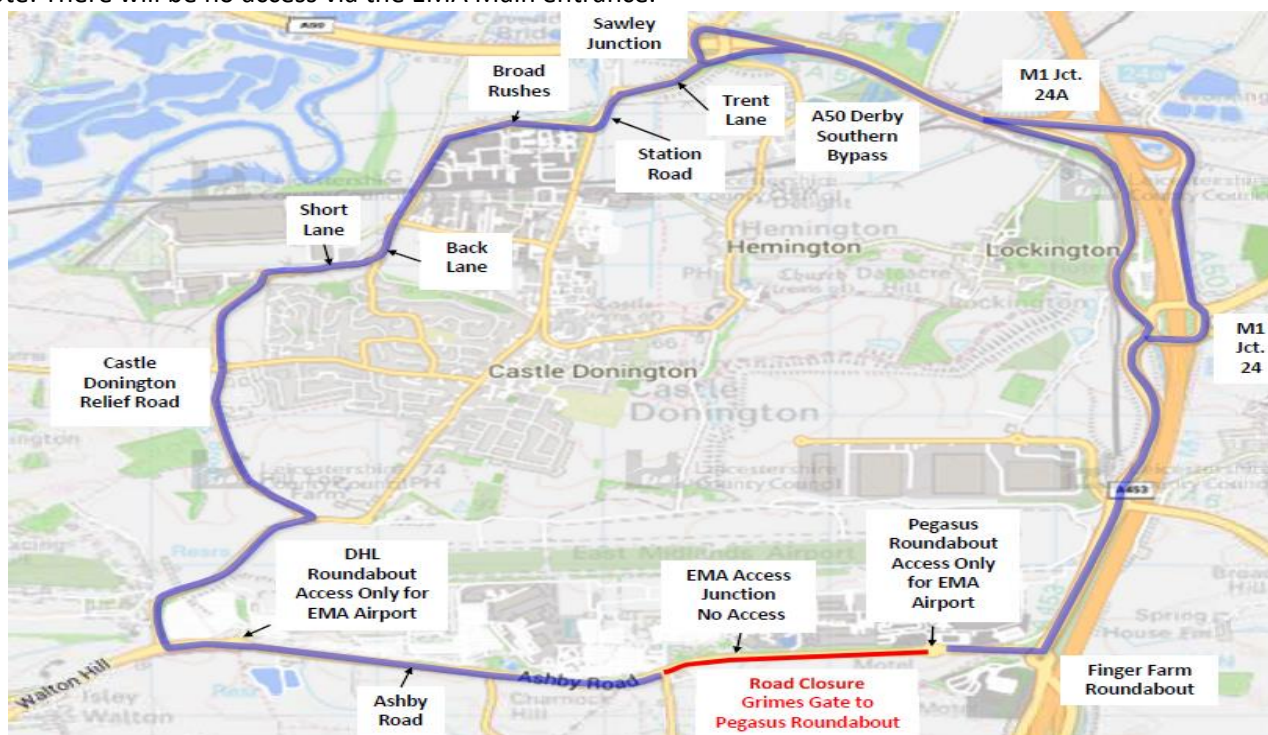
Work will commence on the A453 Ashby Road directly outside the main entrance (at the traffic signals junction) into East Midlands Airport for approximately 230 metres (Jurys Inn).

The road will be fully closed between 20:00-06:00 Monday-Friday, a diversion route will be in place – details attached.

Access to the Airport campus will be maintained from the East via the Pegasus Business Park roundabout and the West via the JetParks / DHL roundabout.

Access to Pegasus Business Park will be maintained from the East via the Pegasus Business Park roundabout and the West via the JetParks / DHL roundabout.

Note: There will be no access via the EMA Main entrance.



During the daytime there will be both temporary lane closures and staggered speed restrictions through the area of works to maintain safety.
