



## DIPLOMA IN COMPANY DIRECTION

### Course synopsis

The Diploma in Company Direction is a Masters level (SCQF) qualification and the second stage in our Chartered Director Programme, with a focus on developing your board performance. Three days of practical, simulated boardroom challenges in a safe environment will set you up for the diploma examination and have an immediate impact on your performance as a director (<https://www.iod.com/professional-development/chartered-director-programme/diploma-in-company-direction/>).

### Price

£3,500 (IoD member) / £5,500 (IoD non-member).

### Exam

To obtain the diploma, you'll need to complete the Developing Board Performance module and pass a three-hour exam. We publish a standard exam question beforehand, which you'll need to answer in relation to a case study released on the day of the exam.

### Exam Price

£600 (to be paid directly to IoD Pall Mall when confirming exam time/date)

### Exam dates

IoD diploma-level qualifications are internationally recognised and credit-rated under the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF). Exams are flexible and can be taken at various dates throughout the year at a time that works best for you. They are completed using a computer-based testing system and are remotely invigilated allowing you to choose when and where you take them.

The exam dates available after completion of the course are;

20th November 2024
