1. WELCOME

Welcome to the MODE IT online self-assessment tool! This tool was created by the partnership of the Erasmus+ project Curricular Modernization by Implementing MOOC Model (short, MODE IT). OpenupEd (https://www.openuped.eu/) defines MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) as:

- online courses designed for large numbers of participants,
- accessible by anyone, anywhere, as long as they have an internet connection,
- open to everyone without entry qualifications,
- offering a full/complete course experience online for free.

The goal of MODE IT is to introduce innovative MOOC-based pedagogical approaches to the design and delivery of higher education courses. The MODE IT online self-assessment tool allows teaching staff at higher education institutions to check their competence level in the design and development of MOOCs, and to get an immediate feedback for possible improvements. The self-assessment tool not only provides a real-time feedback on your individual competences related to the design and development of MOOCs. It also offers concrete suggestions for competence improvement in a specific domain! Moreover, you will get the opportunity to increase your competence level by enrolling in the corresponding online training program that will be developed by MODE IT team. Depending on the identified proficiency level, you might be suggested to complete either the entire training or only specific module(s).
















2. URL LINK

The MODE-IT self-assessment tool is a web application hosted by KTU (Kaunas University of Technology). You can use any web browser to access it at the following URL:


















3. SITE LANGUAGE

The language of the site can be setup in the top menu. Currently English and Lithuanian are available but Portuguese, German, Romanian and Turkish will be available soon.


















4. CHOOSE THE SELF-ASSESSMENT IN YOUR LANGUAGE








5A. LOGIN IN THE PLATFORM








5B. LOGIN IN THE PLATFORM

Either enter the data for your platform account or select to login with a Google account.


















5C. LOGIN IN THE PLATFORM (USING A GOOGLE ACCOUNT)

If you selected a Google account, you'll be taken to the Google environment to enter your data.




















5D. LOGIN IN THE PLATFORM (POLICIES)










7. THE SELF-ASSESSMENT TOOL. This is the entry page for the self-assessment tool and training programme.



































8. SELF-ASSESSING ONE COMPETENCE AREA

When you click on one of the links to self-assess a comeptence are, you'll be taken to this screen. Here you can find an explanation about this competence area.












































































