Wash'Em Training Materials

Are you delivering face-to-face or online blended Wash'Em training? We have newly updated training packages ready for you to use in English, Spanish and French. <u>Contact us</u> for access to the materials described below and for support in using them with your target audience..

- Self-directed study is ideal for individuals who want a deeper understanding of Wash'Em, but have limited schedules or prefer to learn in their own time. The training program takes approximately 10 hours to complete.
 - Self-directed training is available in English, Spanish and French. It can be done through the Wash'Em platform, or by uploading the course on your organizations' internal learning management system. <u>Contact us</u> to sign up for the training, or learn how to host it on your organization's platform.
- Blended training is ideal for professionals who want the opportunity to practice using the Wash'Em tools with peers around the world. It can be a great way of training people in multiple countries at once.
 - Training involves approximately 10 hours of independent work and 14 hours of scheduled live online practice, typically over two to three weeks. Participants are strongly encouraged to complete the required independent study components before the live sessions.
 - Materials are available in English, Spanish, and French for running a blended online training. Participants complete the self-directed course first and supplement it with live virtual or classroom sessions to practice the use of the rapid assessment tools. We can support you to run a self-directed training for your organization, and provide you with all the materials you need for the virtual sessions. Online sessions are facilitated using the materials provided in the face-to-face training packages.
- Face-to-face training is ideal for WASH managers and frontline staff. It provides the opportunity to directly interact with instructors and peers and get hands-on practice using the Wash'Em tools. Training is generally delivered in three days.
 - We have two face-to-face training packages available in English, Spanish and French. The complete face-to-face training package comes with all the lesson plans, slides, and handouts that you need to run a training for a large cohort of participants. The staff orientation handbook, available in English, French, and Spanish is designed to help you run a leaner version of this training, with a small group of staff, when you have limited time available for training and plan to use the Wash'Em process as part of immediate program work.
