Georgia's Pledge under the Paris Agreement

Georgia has committed to an unconditional limiting target of 35% below 1990 level of its domestic total greenhouse gas emissions by 2030. The country has also committed to reducing its total greenhouse gas emissions by 50-57% from 1990 levels by 2030 if it receives international support.

Georgia's 2030 Climate Change Strategy (CSAP)

For the implementation of NDC, Georgia has a 2030 Climate Change Strategy and a 2021-2023 action plan. The CCS covers 7 climate-relevant sectors: energy generation and transmission, transport, buildings, industry, agriculture, waste management, and forestry. The Georgia's CSAP reflects the main sectoral priorities and concrete activities for attaining climate mitigation goals.

You have a programme idea to cut carbon emissions?

Learn how the KliK Foundation supports the implementation of green technologies and climate mitigation programmes! The Foundation for Climate Protection and Carbon Offset KliK is a private organisation tasked with fulfilling an official role under the Swiss climate legislation in reducing around 20 million tonnes of CO₂ outside of Switzerland under Article 6 of the Paris Agreement until 2030. Therefore, the KliK Foundation aims to procure around 20 million tonnes of eligible emission reductions in the form of Internationally Transferred Mitigation Outcomes (ITMOs) generated by greenhouse gas mitigation programmes until the end of 2030. To apply for financial support from the KliK Foundation, follow the participation process outlined in the Climate Action Wheel.

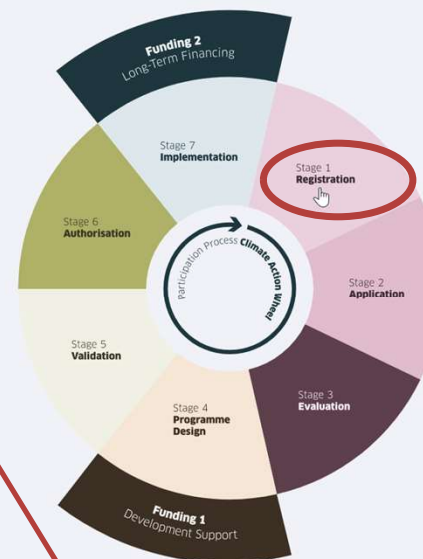
Do you have a climate action idea? One that mitigates emissions, in addition to the national commitment on climate action (Nationally Determined Contributions, NDCs) of the host country? Do you want to develop and implement a mitigation activity and hence need funding for your programme? The KLIK Foundation seeks to purchase mitigation outcomes from mitigation activities carried out under Article 6 of the Paris Agreement and supports you in the implementation process with two funding opportunities:

- **Funding 1:** The KLIK Foundation supports the conceptual development of the mitigation activity programme.
- **Funding 2:** By purchasing the resulting emission reductions of your programme, the KLIK Foundation provides the necessary financial contribution to make the programme financially viable.

In Stage 1 you register as an applicant to apply for funding. In doing so, you are initiating the KLIK Foundation's Climate Action Participation Process.

Before registering, you are invited to acquaint yourself with the general eligibility criteria. These criteria outline the scope of applicants and supported applications.

Once registered, you can create an application to seek support for the development of your climate protection programme in the online application tool (Funding 1), where you will find all the guidance for the application process.

Stage 2 includes (2.1) the elaboration of your programme idea (Mitigation Activity Idea Note, MAIN) as well as (2.2) the realisation of a Letter of Intent (LoI) from both the host country and Switzerland.

The MAIN describes the proposed mitigation activity and contains all the information needed to assess your programme idea against the eligibility criteria. A positive evaluation (Stage 3) grants funding for the development of the detailed proposal (Stage 4).

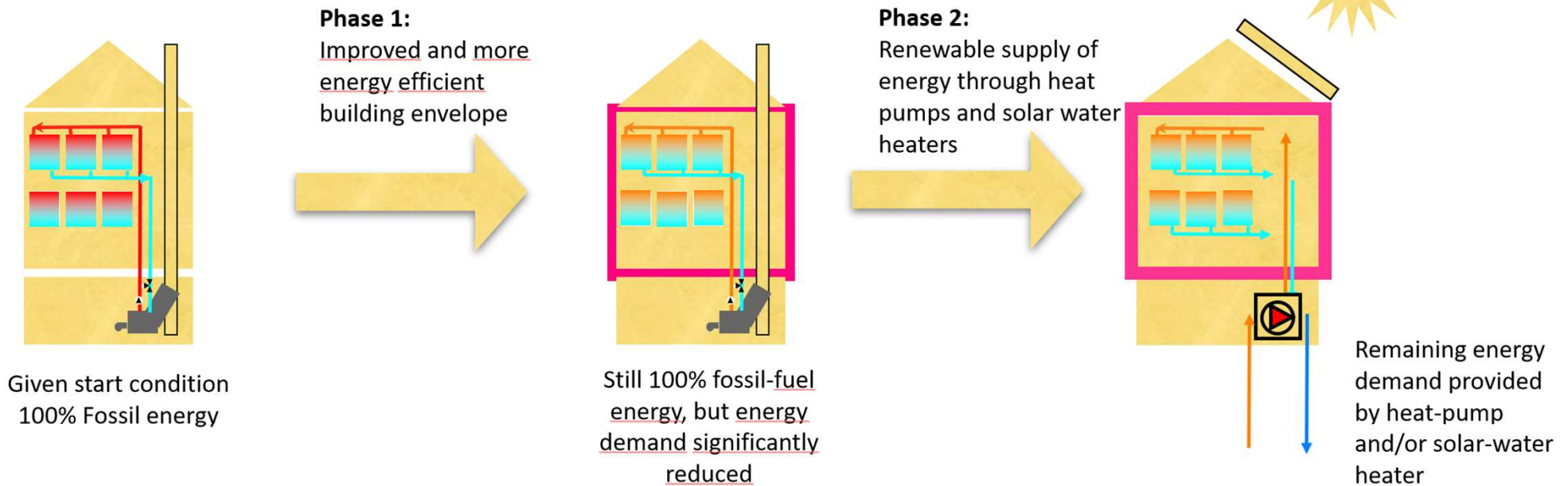

Phased approach of the programme



Scope of the programme

Key target group:

- Gas-heated residential single-household buildings
 - Option to expand the target-group once proof of concept achieved

Technical measures (phased approach):

- Phase 1: Building envelope measures to reduce the energy demand of the building
 - Wall and roof insulation, efficient windows and doors
 - Efficiency standards beyond the minimum legal requirements
- Phase 2 (optional): Sustainable energy supply (focus on heating supply)
 - Heat-pumps and solar-water heater
 - Potential to provide cooling energy through heat-pumps

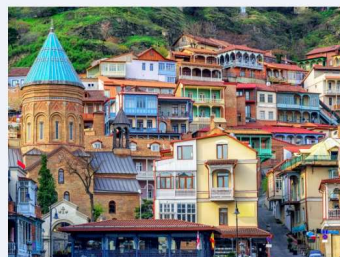
